U.S. TRUSTEE'S LIMITED OBJECTION TO INTERIM APPLICATION FOR COMPENSATION BY ATTORNEYS FOR CREDITORS COMMITTEE

The United States Trustee for Region 17, Tracy Hope Davis (the "UST") hereby files this limited objection to the First Application for Interim Compensation ("Fee Application") filed herein by Dorsey & Whitney LLP, counsel to the Creditors Committee herein ("Counsel").

This case was filed on March 20, 2013. The Fee Application seeks fees totaling \$1,168,598 and expenses of \$5,312.17 for the period beginning with the employment of Counsel (April 3, 2013) and ending February 28, 2014, roughly a ten-month period.

The UST understands that this has been a highly contentious case, with divergent positions taken by the Committee and by the Debtor. This has resulted in, among other things, competing plans and disclosure statements and a motion to appoint a chapter 11 trustee, both of which are still pending and are currently set for continued hearings on April 29. The Debtor and the Committee have attended mediation sessions with Judge Montali and have also had extensive

negotiations to resolve their issues. The UST does not know the current status of these negotiations, and it is not clear how this case will ultimately be resolved.

The Fee Application seeks an enormous amount of money – over \$1.1 million for ten months of work. The UST does not know the extent of fees accrued by Debtor's counsel, but it is likely to be even higher than Committee Counsel's fees; the February 2014 MOR reports cumulative accrued fees to date of \$2,656,098, but it is not known if this is for all professionals or just the Debtor's professionals.

The February 2014 MOR reports that the Debtor has only \$133,606 in the bank. According to the Fee Application (pages 7 and 52), Counsel has received \$525,000, representing the "Committee Carve Out," which Counsel presumably holds pending approval of its fees by the Court.

The UST has not spent an inordinate amount of time reviewing the details of the Fee Application. But it is apparent that there are some aspects of the Fee Application that violate the Court's Guidelines, including billing for two or three attorneys to attend hearings and committee meetings. See, e.g., Exhibit D. There may be other areas as well where there may be duplication of effort and services, or the amounts billed are excessive, unnecessary or unreasonable.

The UST recognizes that this is an interim application. Under the circumstances, and until the ultimate direction of this case becomes clear, the UST suggests that the Court only allow some percentage of the fees requested, and withhold allowance of the balance until such time as a final application is filed. The UST suggests a holdback of at least 25-30% of the requested fees.

The UST has no objection to the allowance of Counsel's expenses in the amount of \$5,312.17.

This limited objection is without prejudice to the UST's right to object to Counsel's fees in a final fee application, and the UST reserves all such rights.
