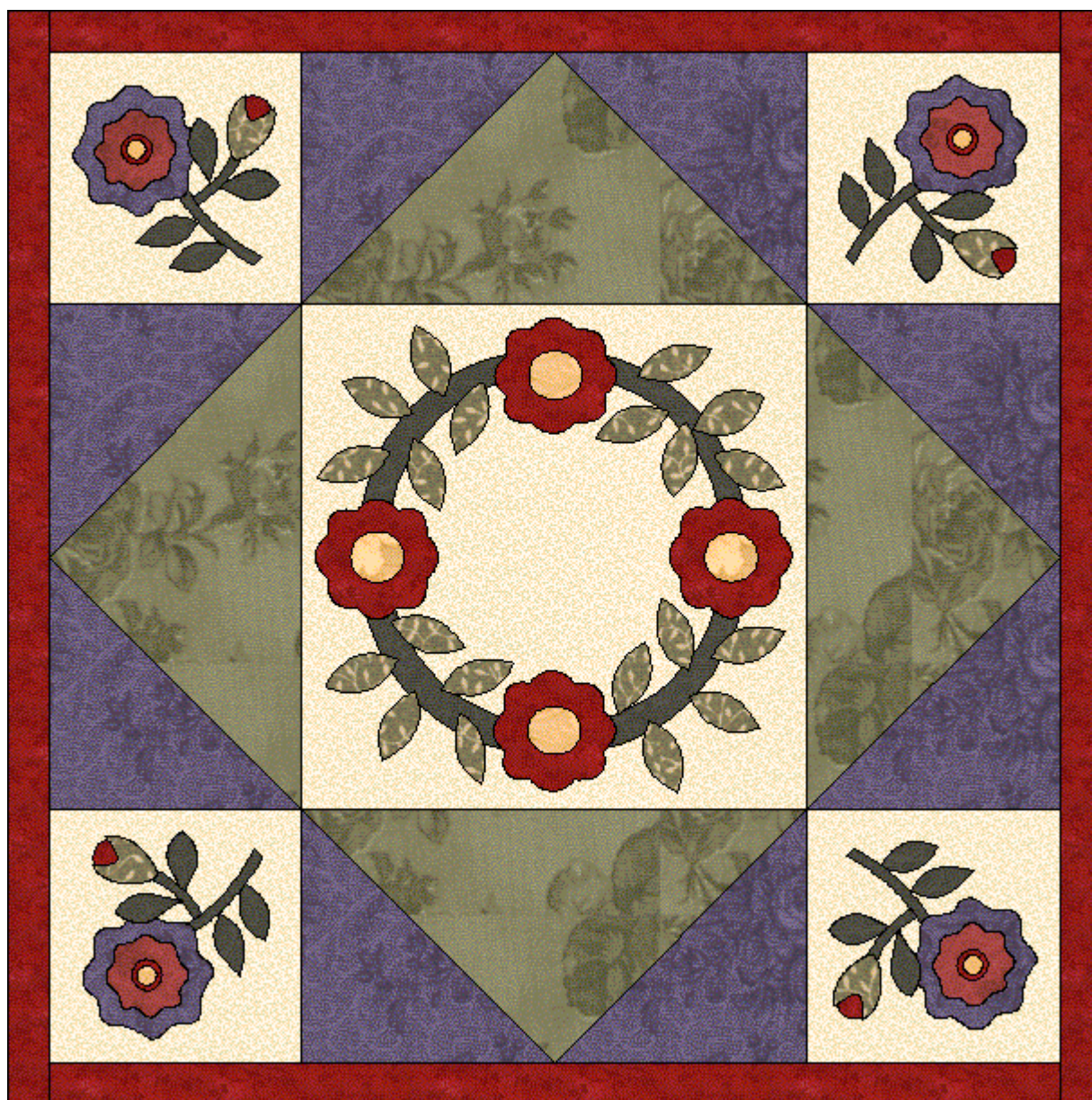




## *One-Block Project Pattern*



26-1/2" x 26-1/2"

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## Fabric Requirements

-  1/2 yard cream print for background
-  1 fat quarter medium green print for setting triangles
-  3/8 yard medium blue print for setting triangles and appliqué pieces
-  5/8 yard red print for border and binding
-  1 fat quarter light green print for appliqué pieces
-  1 fat quarter dark green print for appliqué pieces
-  1 fat eighth dark pink print for appliqué pieces
-  1 fat eighth yellow print for appliqué pieces
- 7/8 yard fabric for backing

## Cutting Requirements

### Cream

- (1) 13" square
- (4) 7" squares

### Medium Green

(2) 9-1/4" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally for a total of 4 half-square triangles.

### Medium Blue

(4) 6-7/8" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally for a total of 8 half-square triangles.

### Red

- (2) 1-1/2" x 24-1/2" strips for top and bottom borders
- (2) 1-1/2" x 26-1/2" strips for side borders
- (3) 2-1/4" strips for binding

### Remaining Fabric

Using the cover illustration as a guide for color placement cut the appliqué pieces from the remaining fabric. Templates and block layouts are provided at the end of this file. You will need to cut 4 of each piece for the corner blocks.

## Appliqué

Using your favorite appliqué method, stitch the center block and the four corner blocks. Trim the completed center block to 12-1/2" square and each corner block to 6-1/2" square.

## Piecing

1. With right sides together, sew a medium green triangle to opposite sides of the center block. Then, sew the remaining two green triangles to the other two sides of the center block. The resulting center block assembly should measure 17-1/2" square.



2. Referring to the diagram below, make 4 corner triangle assemblies.



3. Sew a corner triangle assembly to opposite sides of the center block assembly you created in Step 1. Then, sew the remaining two corner triangle assemblies to the other two sides of the center block assembly. Your piece should now measure 24-1/2" square.



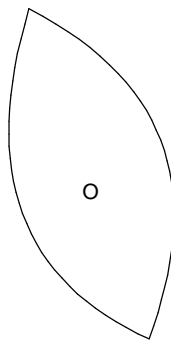
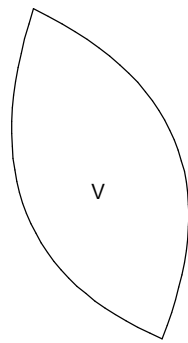
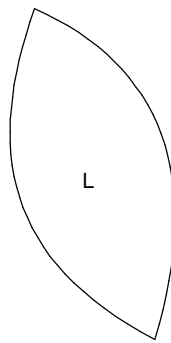
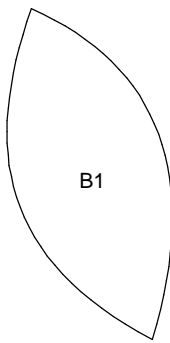
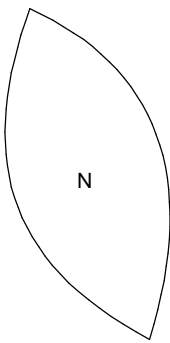
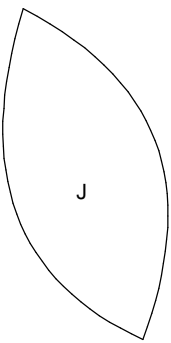
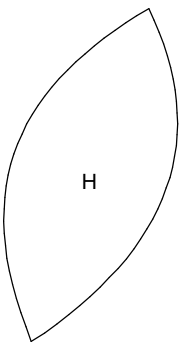
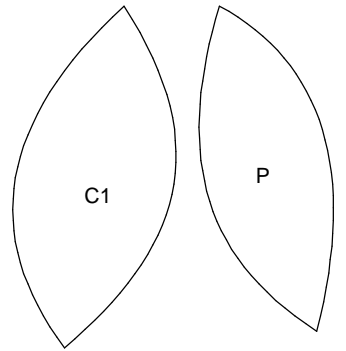
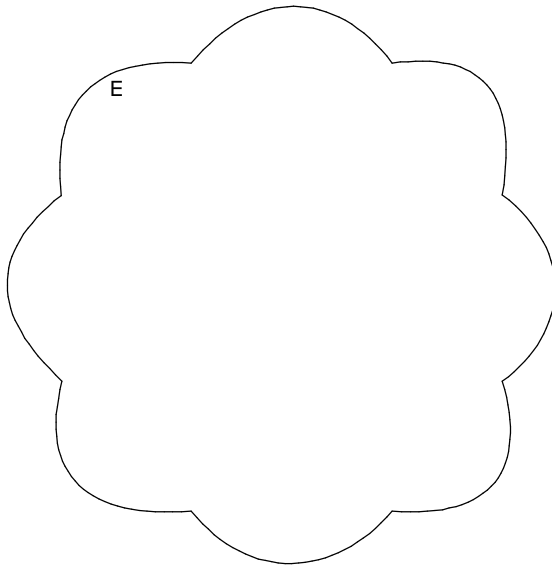
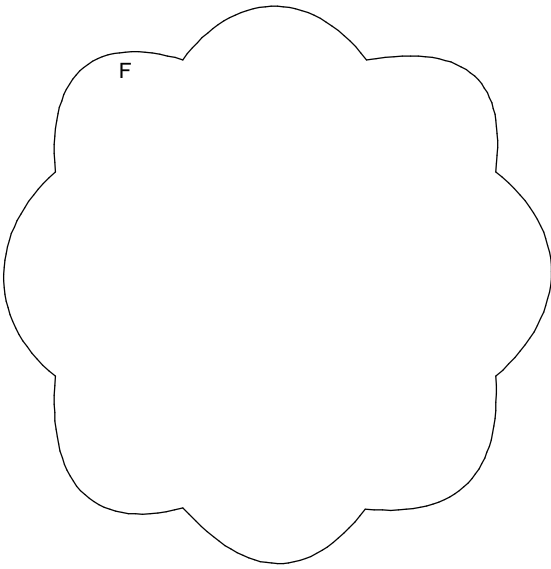
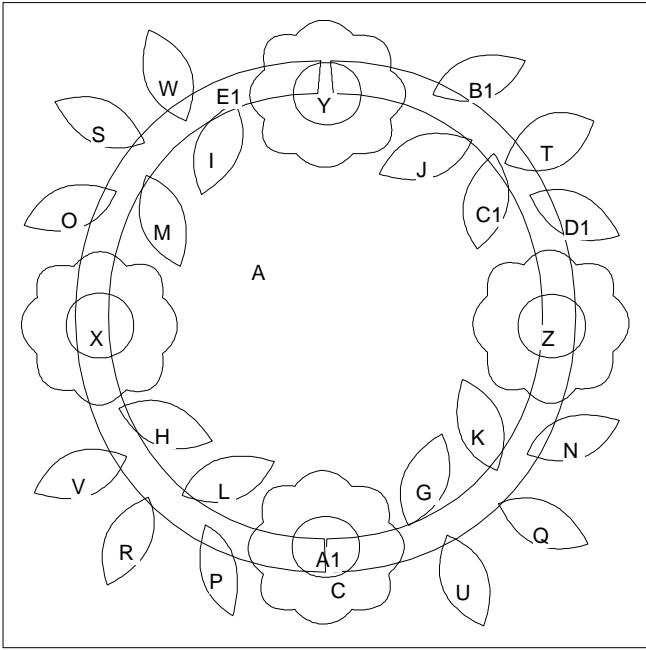
4. Add the top and bottom borders, and then add the side borders.

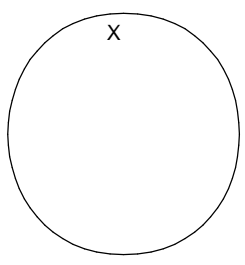
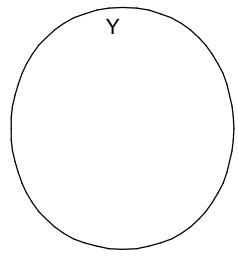
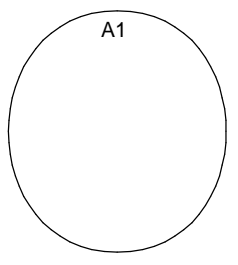
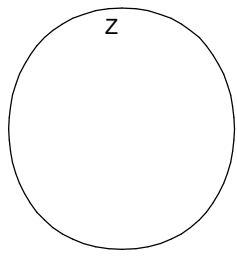
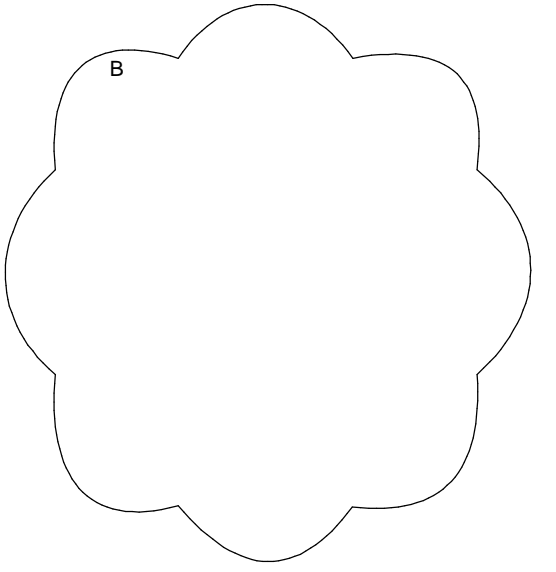
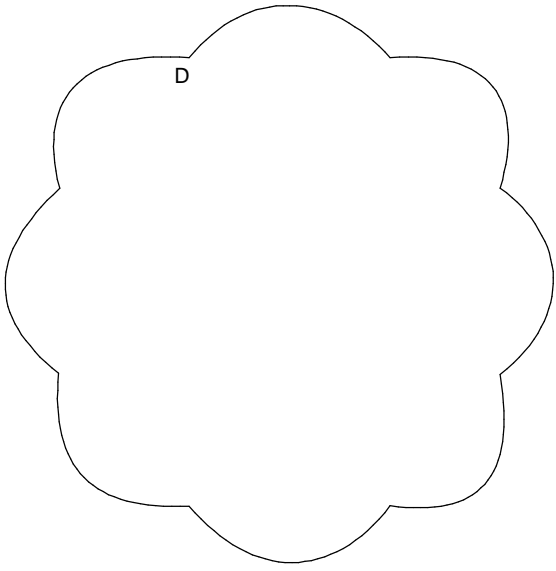
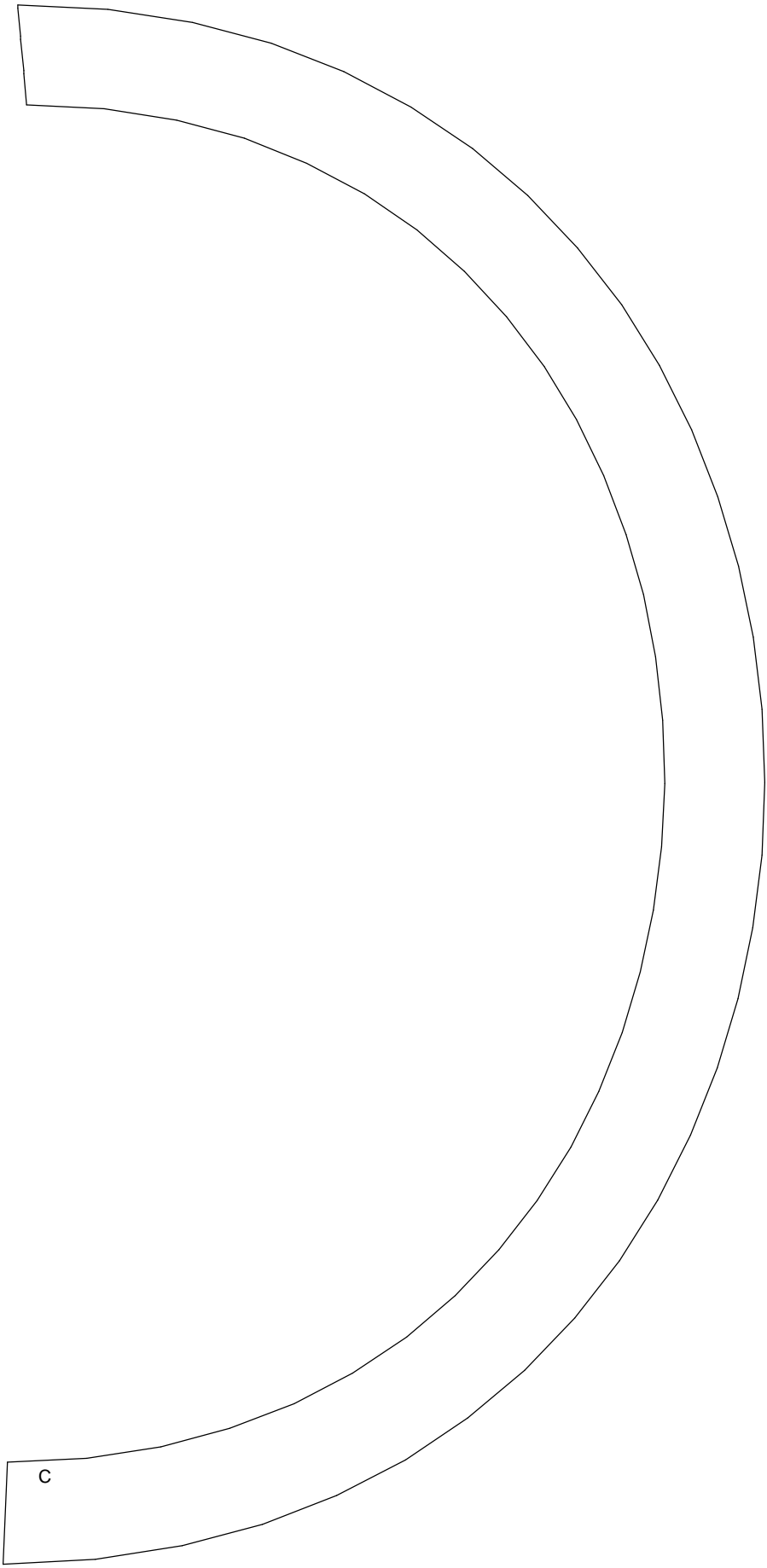


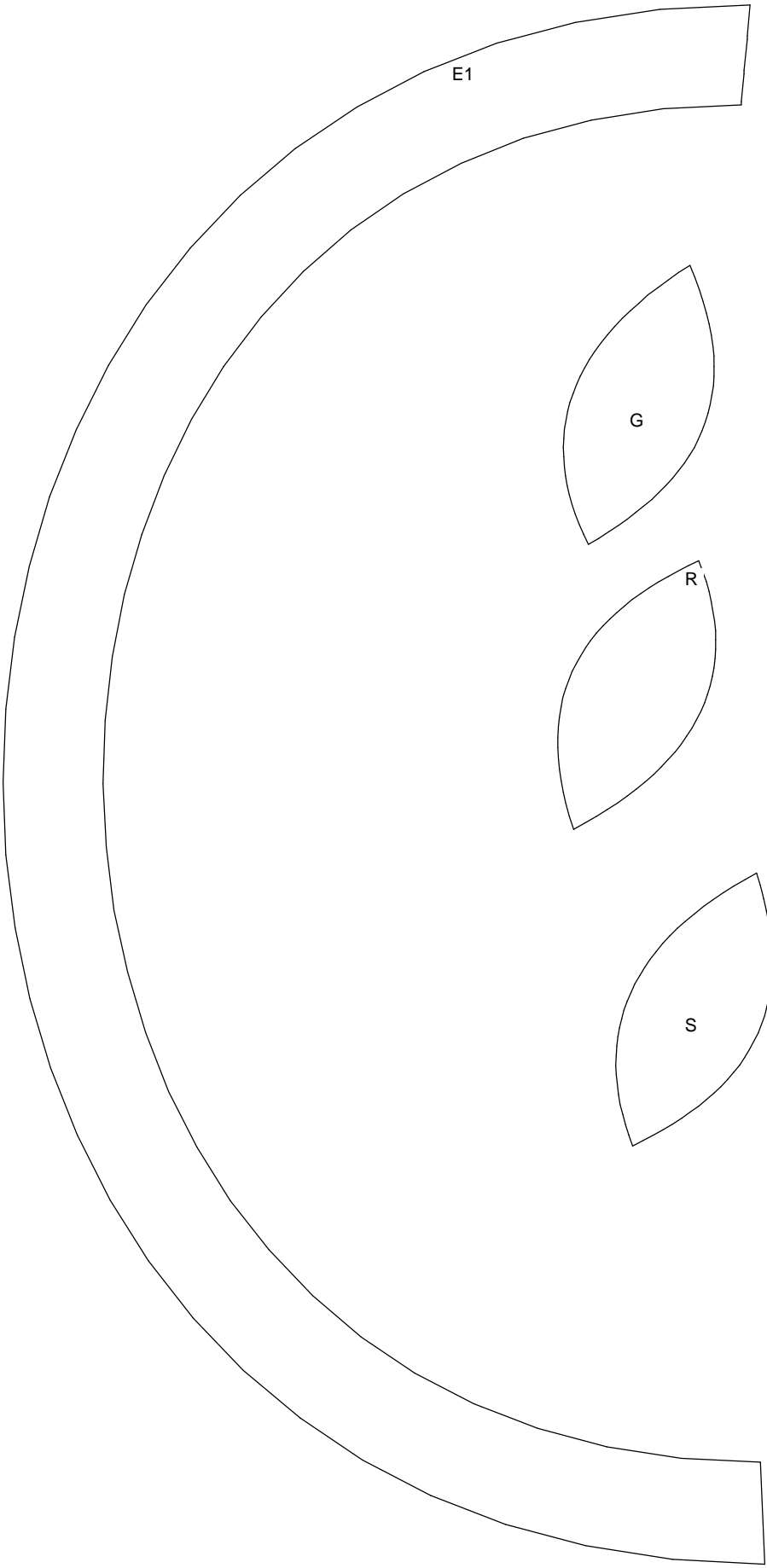
## *Finishing*

1. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top; baste. Quilt as desired.
2. Join 2-1/4"-wide red strips into 1 continuous piece for binding. Add binding to quilt.

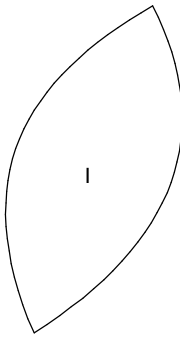
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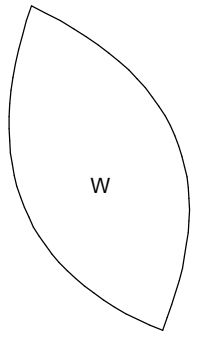




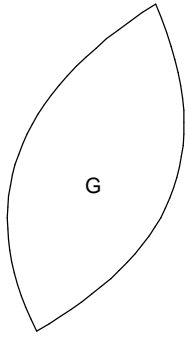
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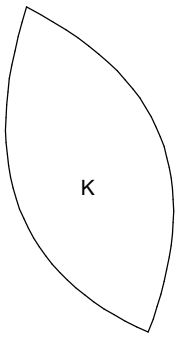
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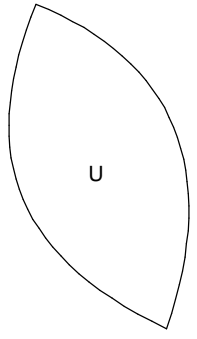
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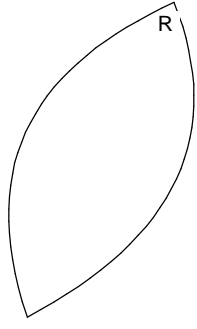
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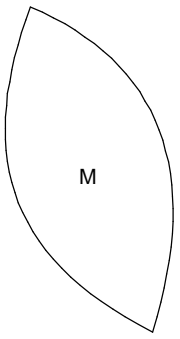
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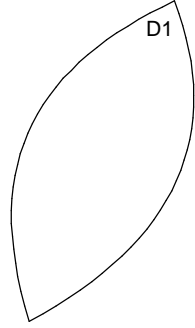
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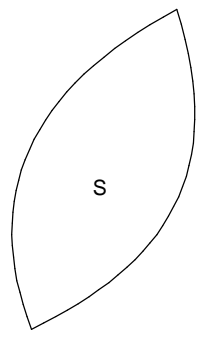
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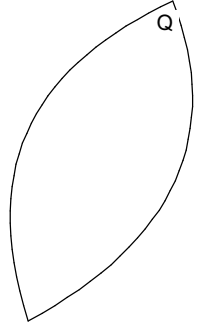
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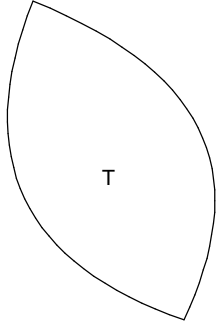
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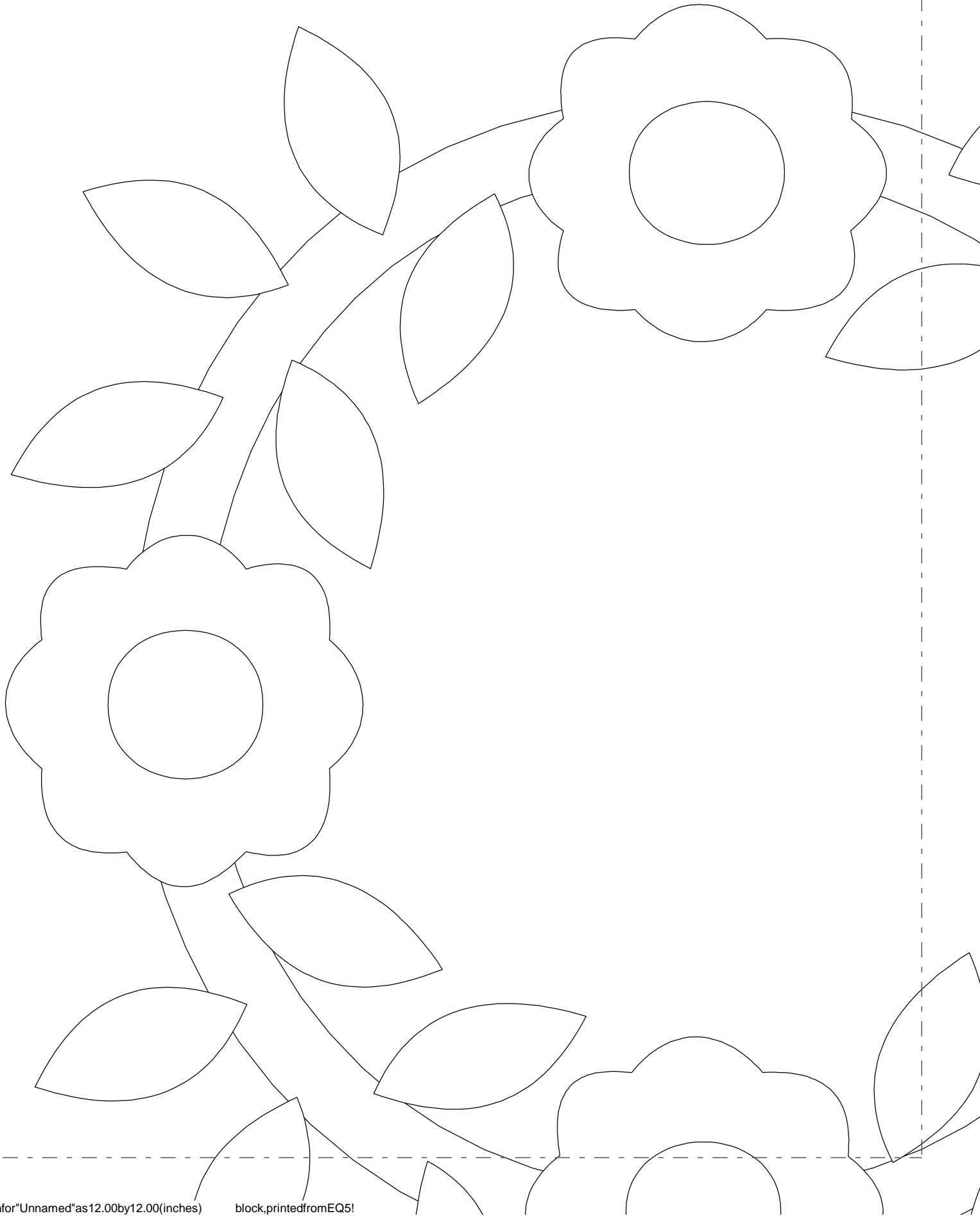
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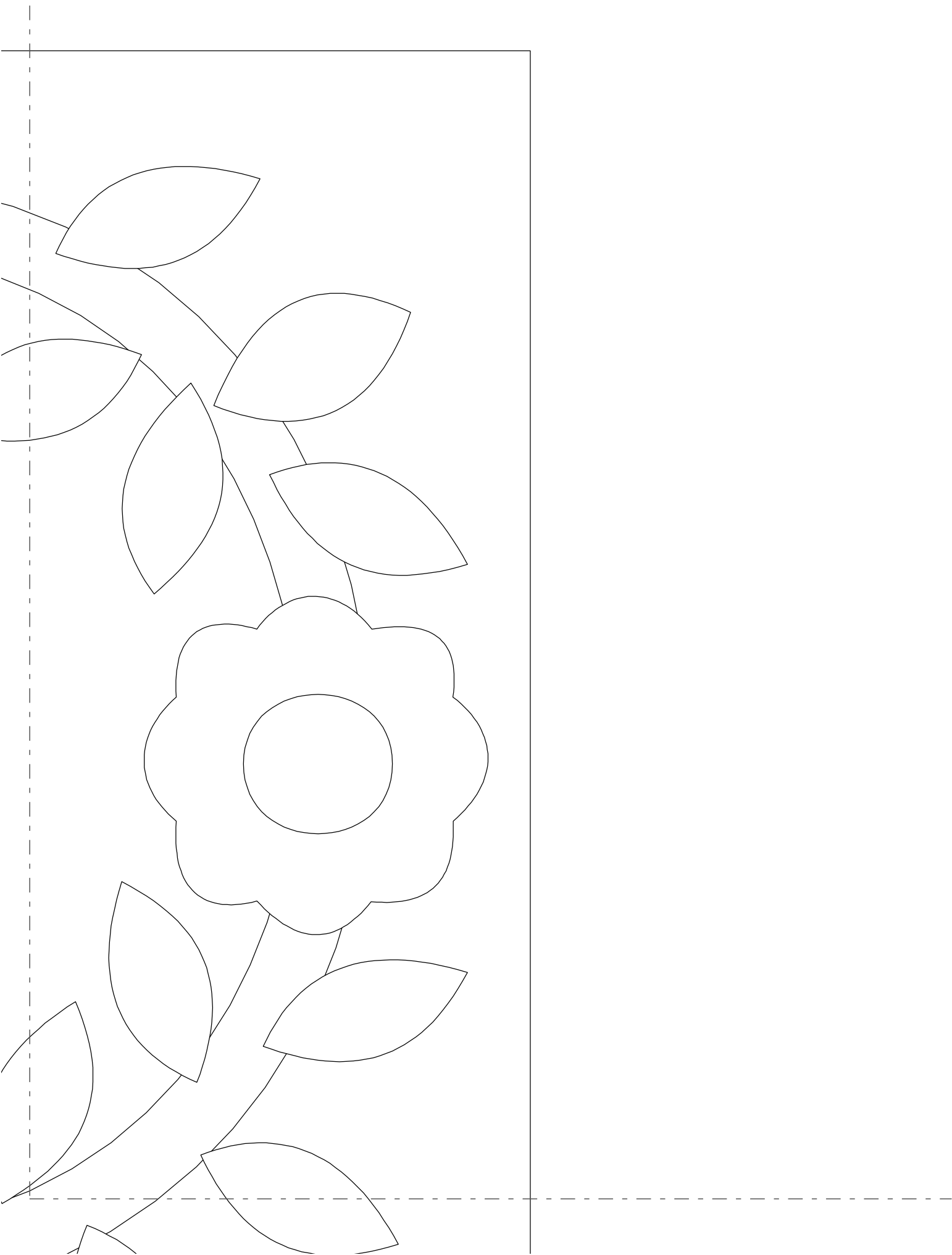


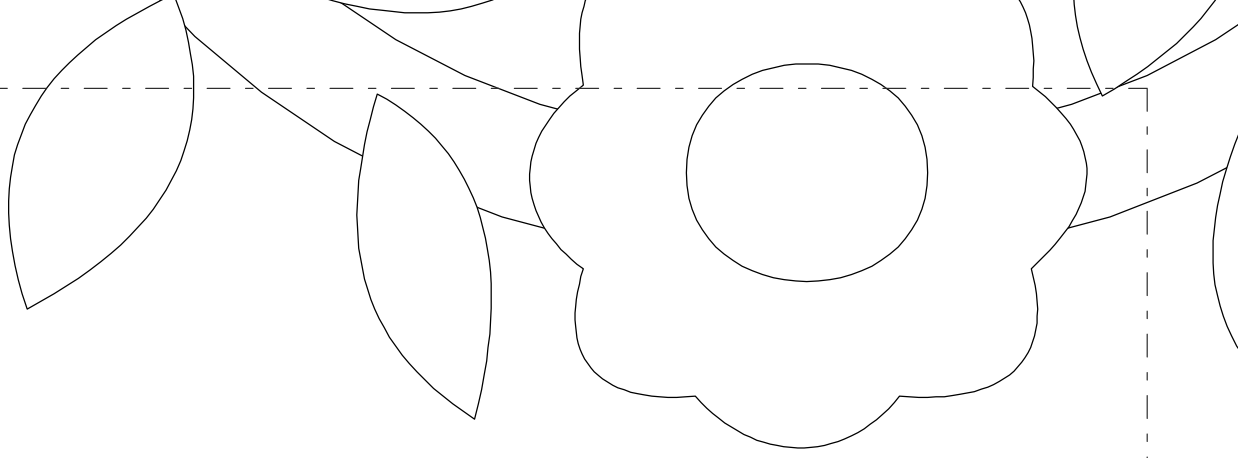
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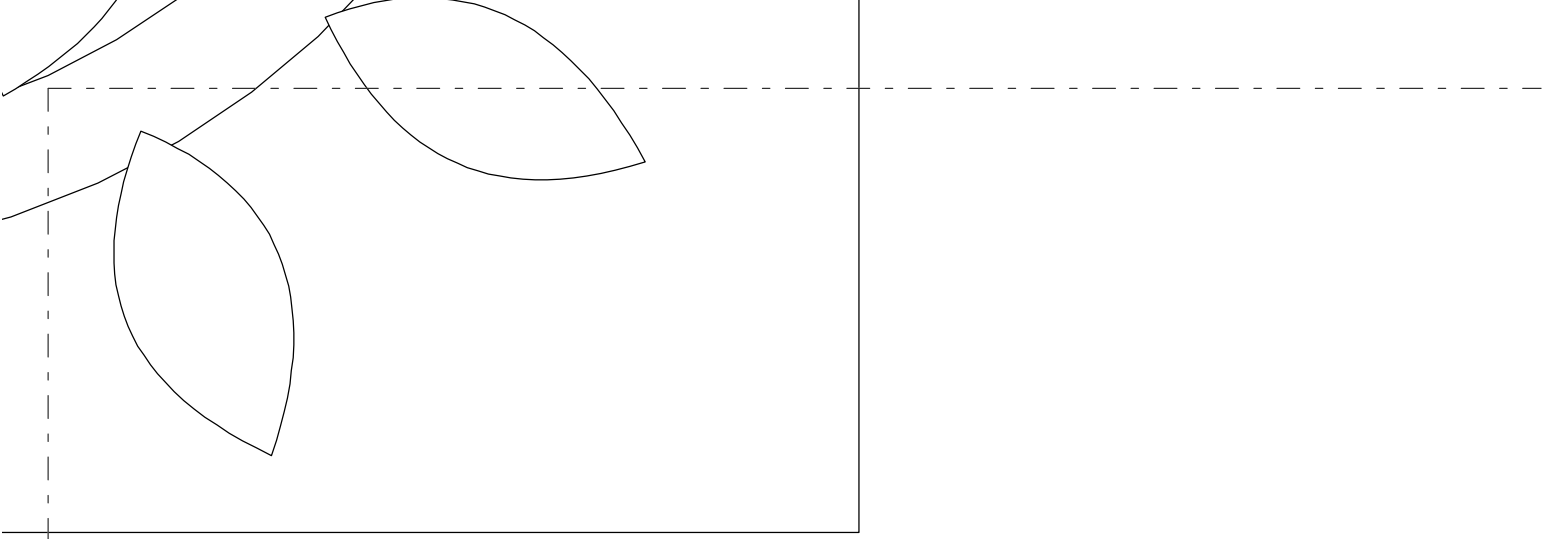


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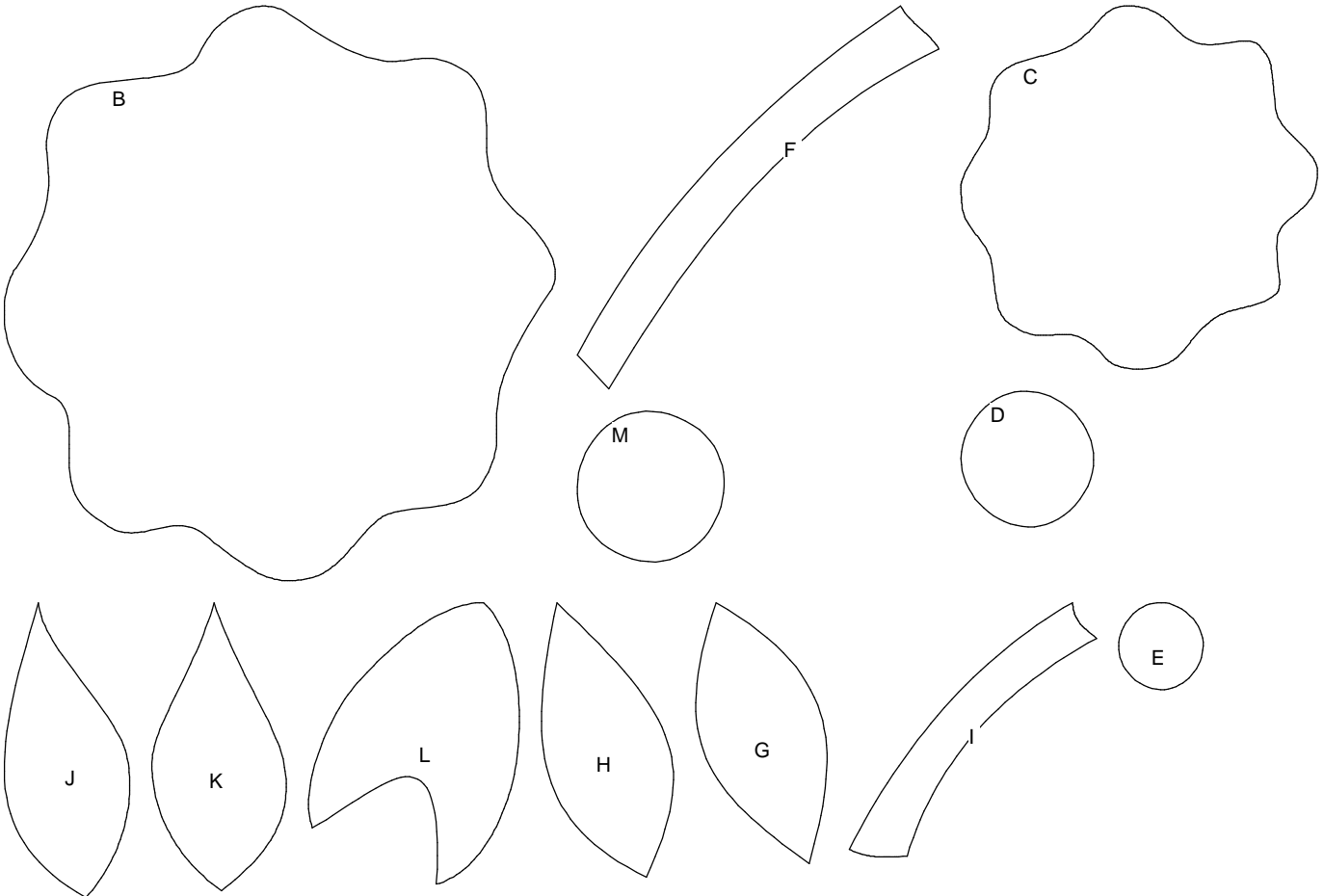
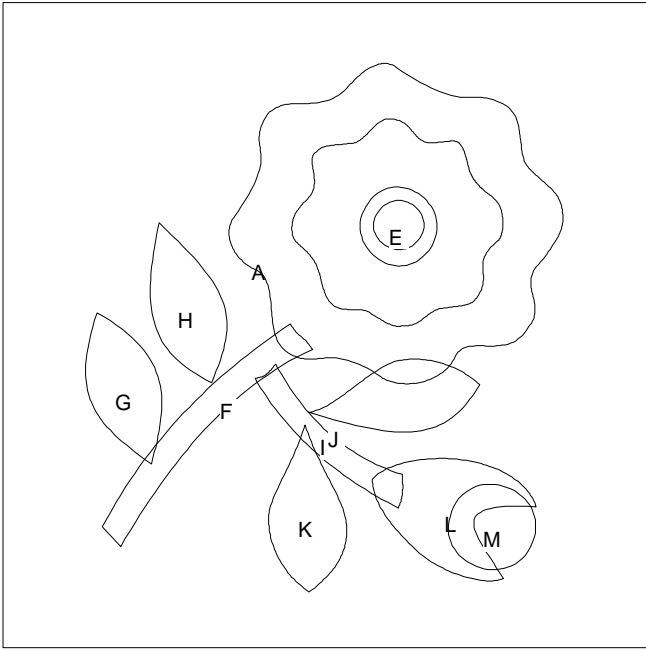








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
