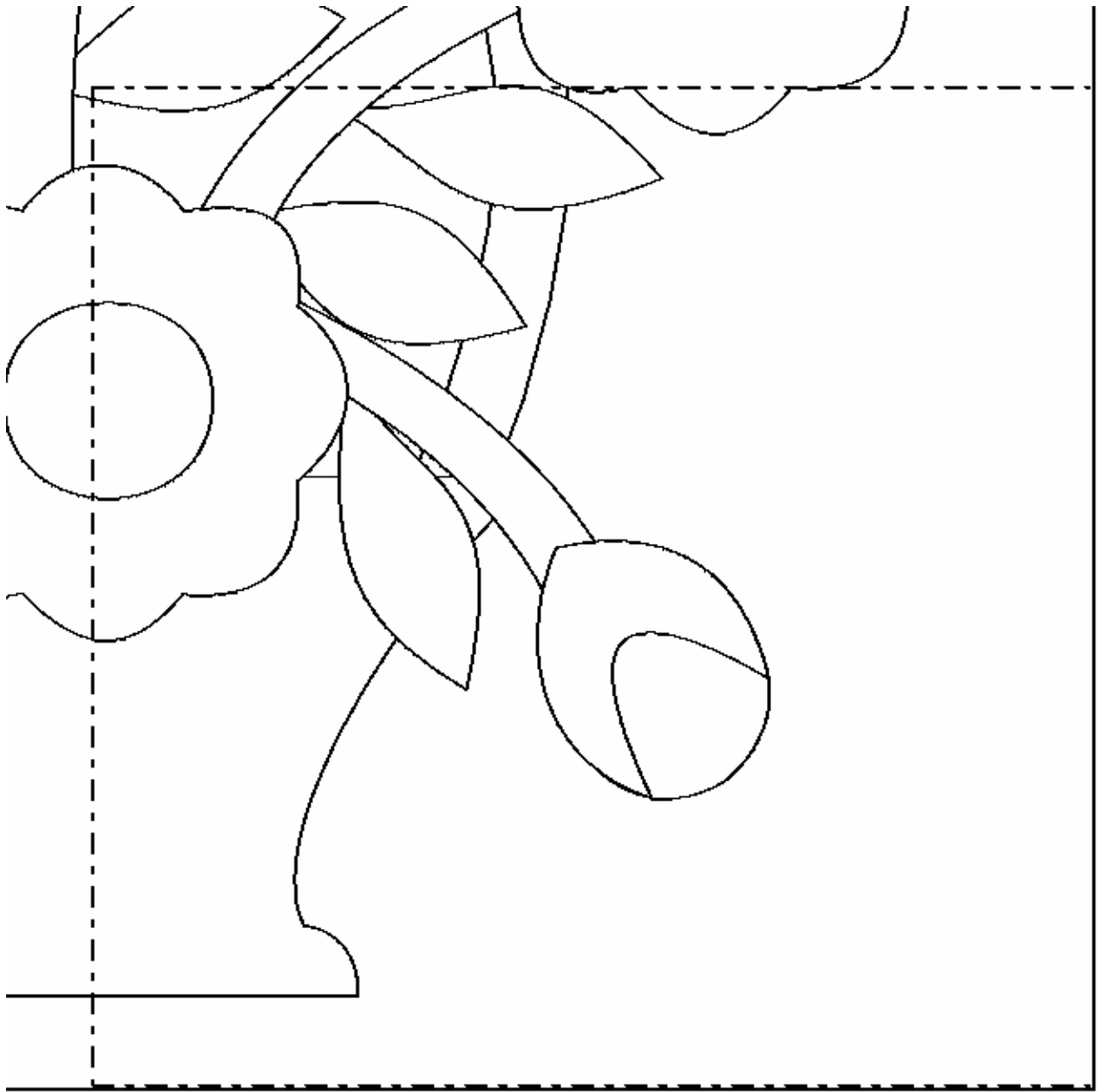
## Color Key

	Cream	Background; cut one 13" square and trim to 12-1/2" square after appliqué is complete.
	Light Green	Basket
	Medium Green	Leaves
	Dark Green	Stems
	Light Pink	Rosebuds
	Dark Pink	Flowers
	Red	Flowers
	Yellow	Flower Centers
	Medium Blue	Bluebird
	Dark Blue	Bluebird Wing









## Templates

If you are using freezer paper on the back of your pieces or fusible appliqué, you'll need to print the templates on the following pages as mirror images. Look for a mirror option in your printer driver.

Templates are included for the basket handle and stems, but bias tubes would probably be easier for these pieces. Also, the bluebird's eye would be best embroidered with satin stitch. But since I forgot to delete it, there is also a teeny tiny circle template for the eye.
