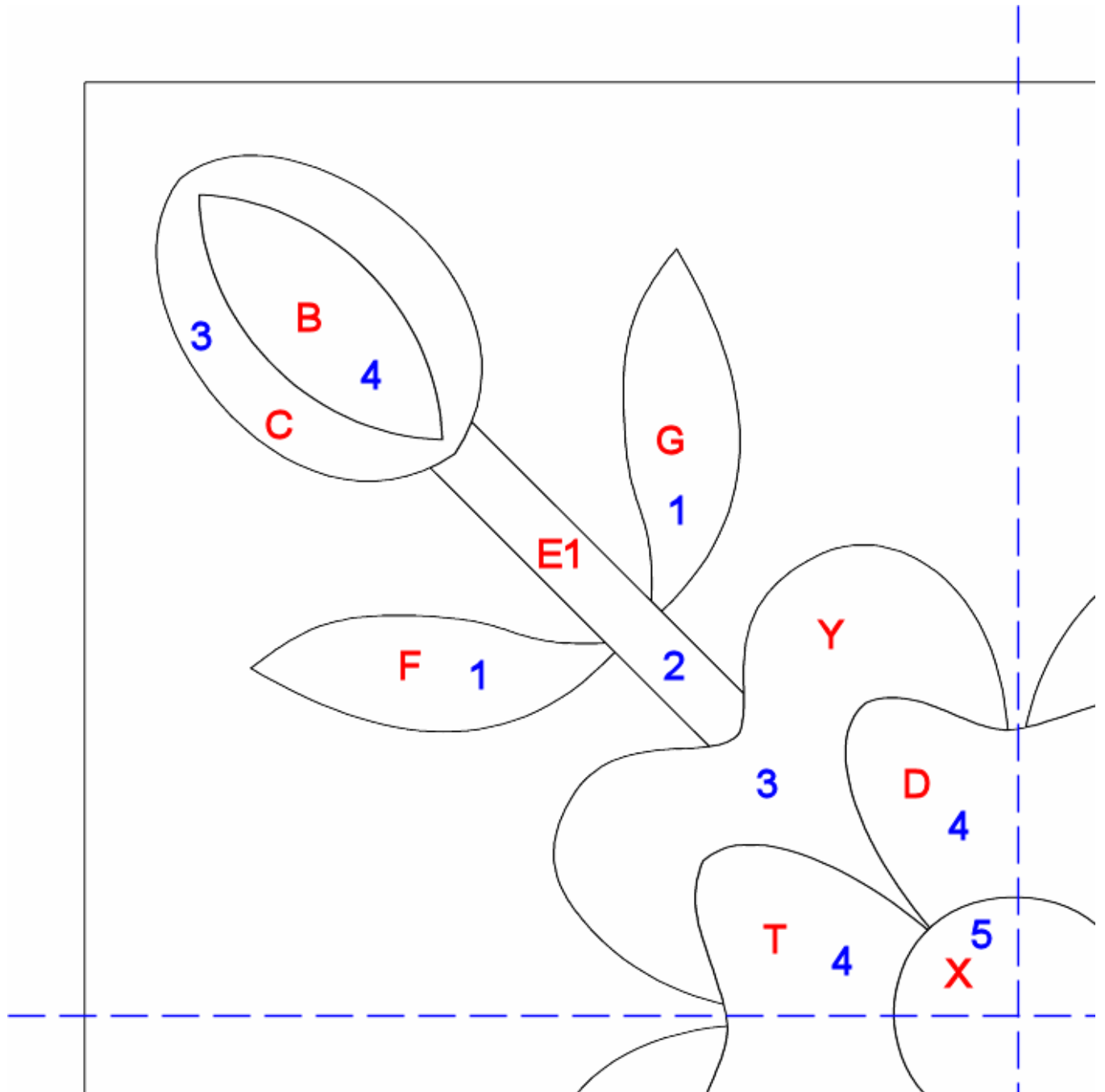
Block size: 12" x 12"

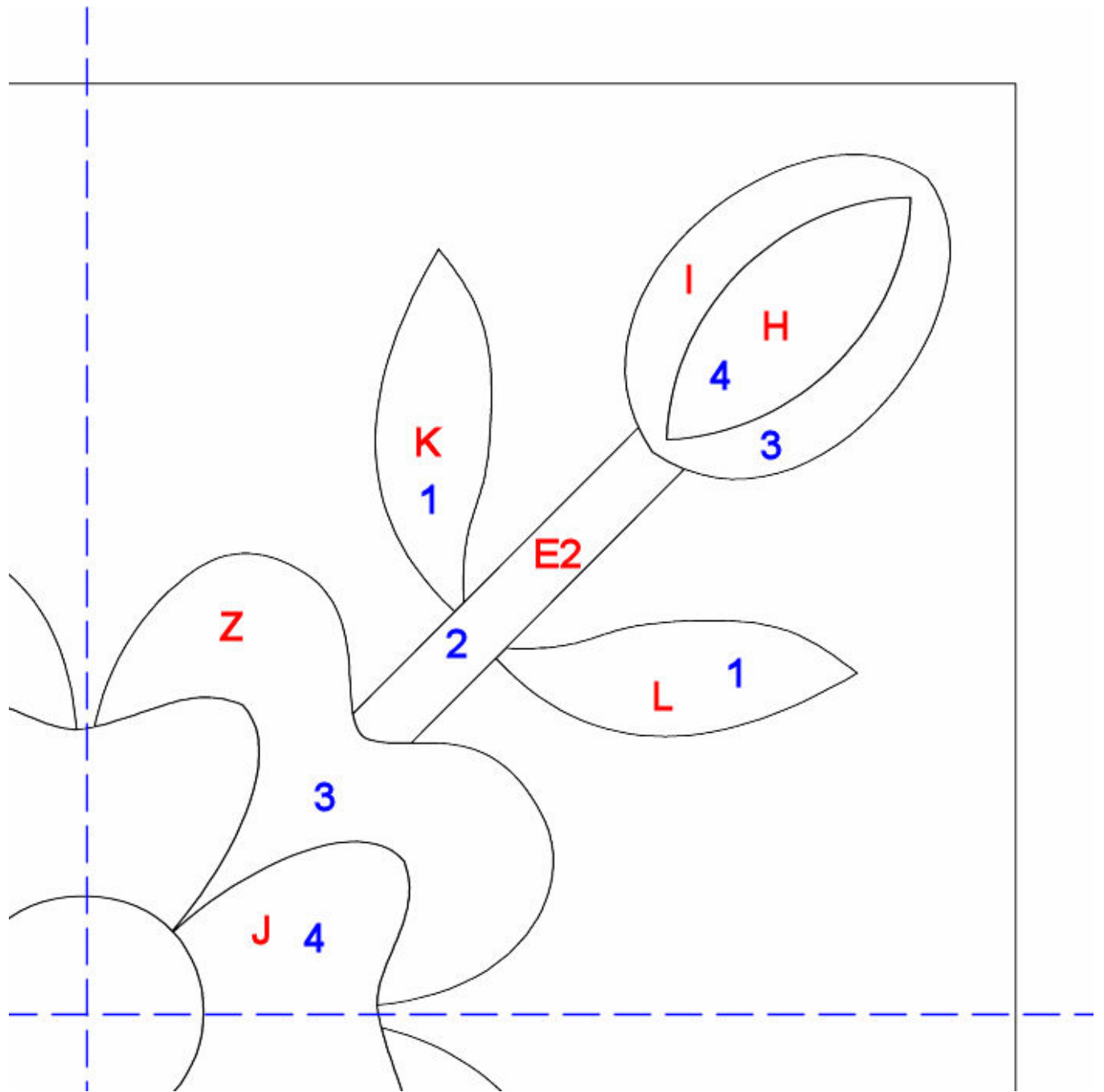
Color Key

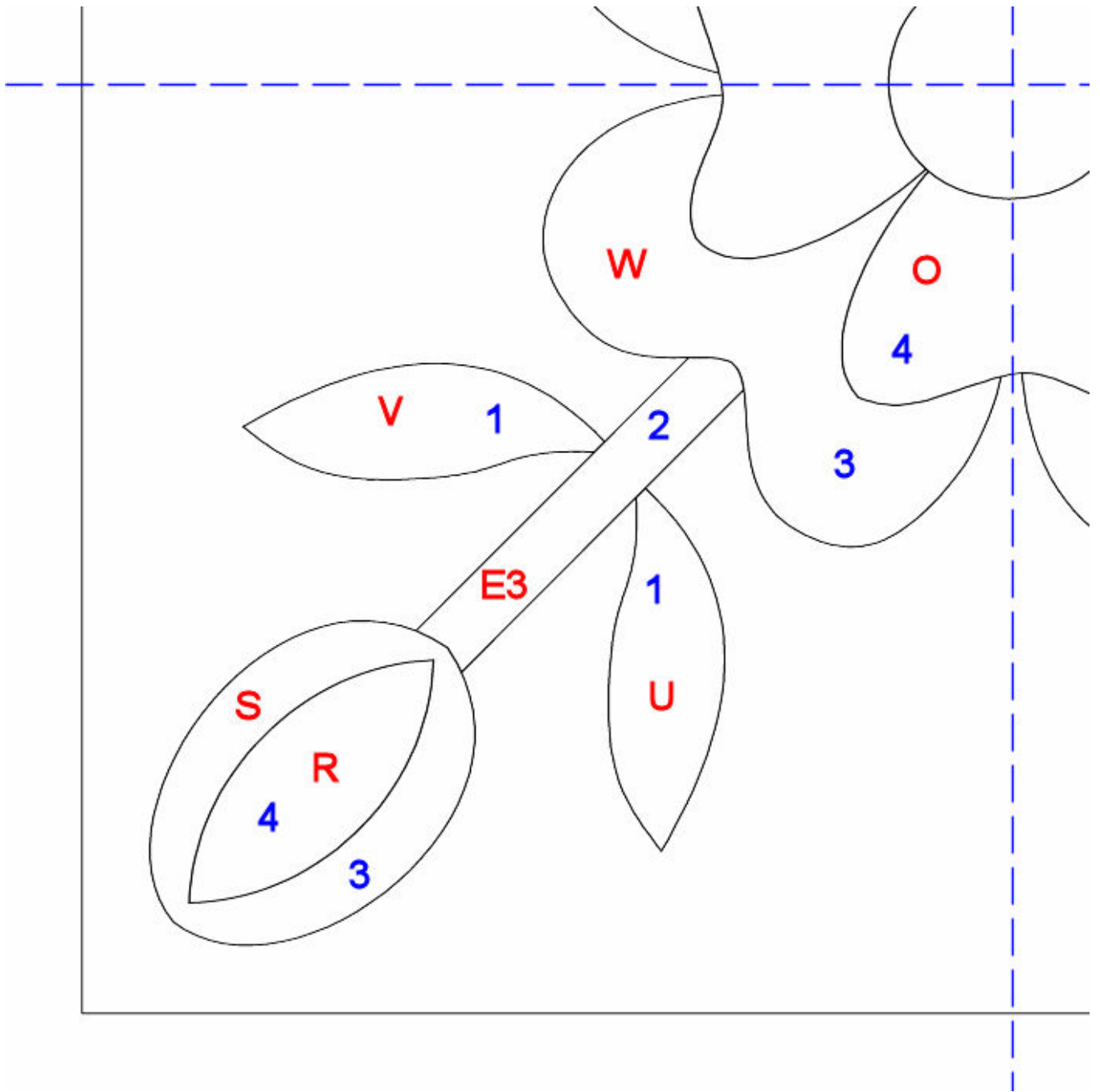
	Cream	Background; cut one 13" square and trim to 12-1/2" square after appliqué is complete.
	Medium Green	Leaves F, G, K, L, P, Q, U, V
	Dark Green	Stems E1, E2, E3, E4
	Light Pink	Rosebud Centers B, H, M, R; Rose Inner Petals D, J, O, T
	Red	Rosebuds C, I, N, S; Rose Outer Petals A, W, Y, Z
	Yellow	Rose Center X

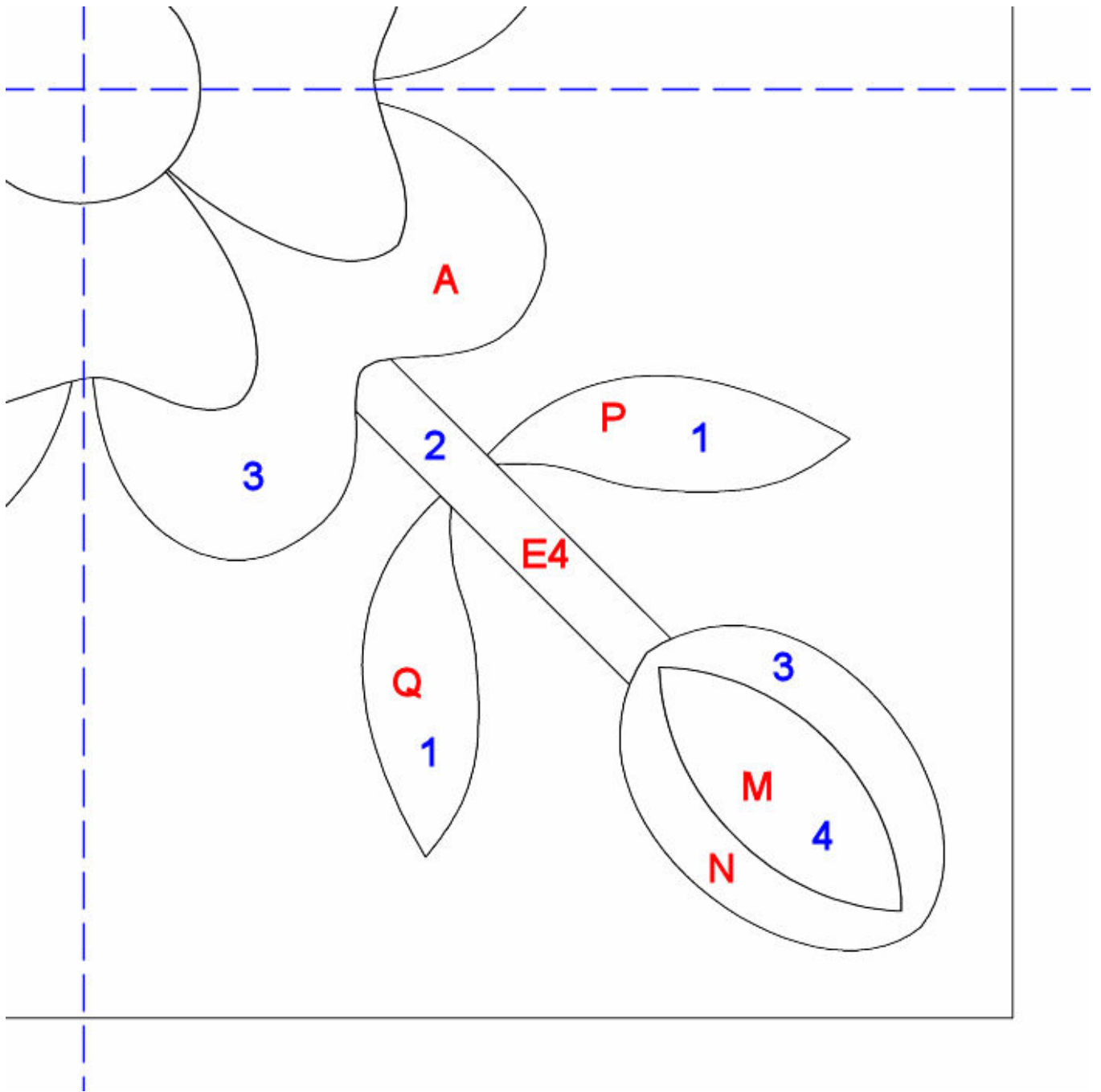
Layout Guides

The letters in red identify each piece and correspond to the letters given in the Color Key. The numbers in blue indicate the order in which the pieces should be applied to the background.



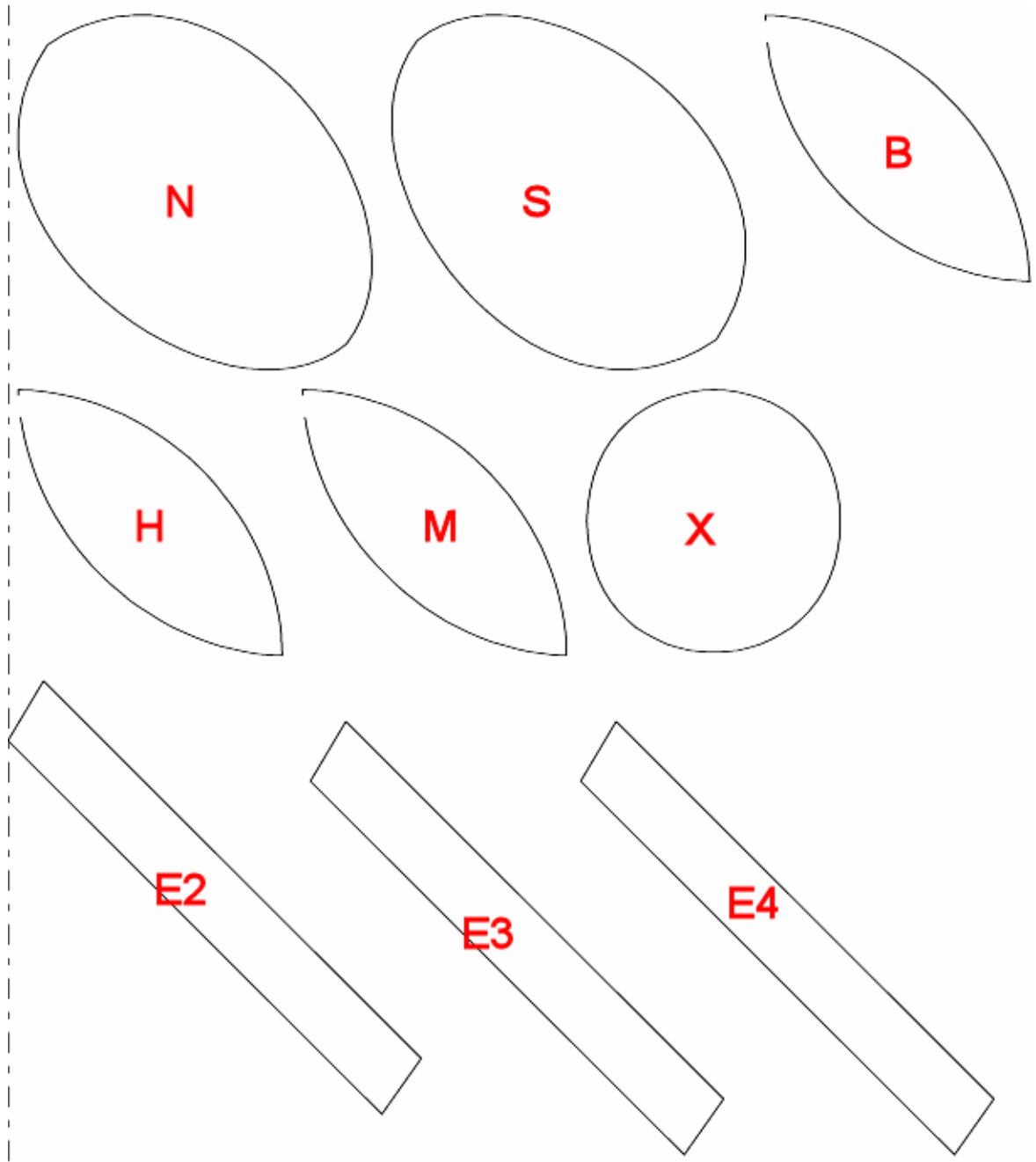


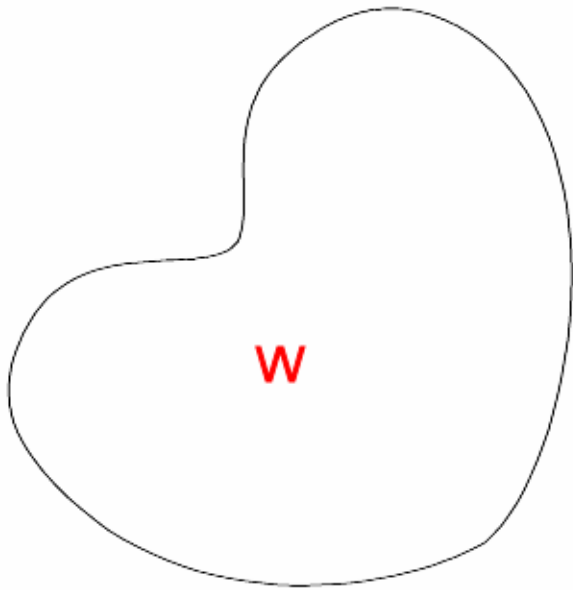




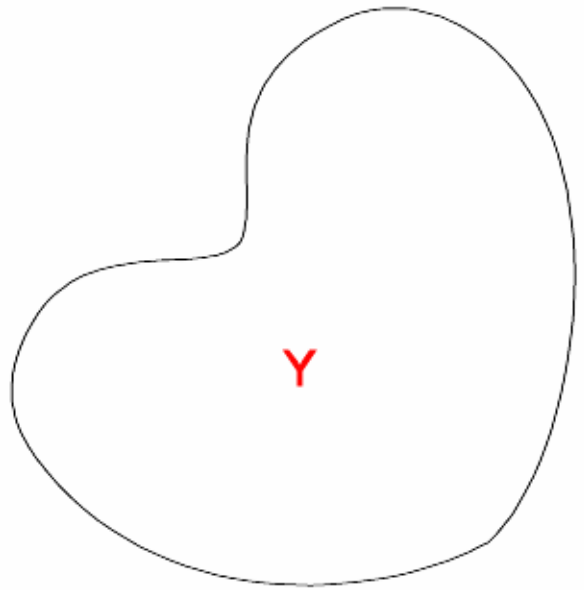
Templates
