# Numbers, Symbols & Words

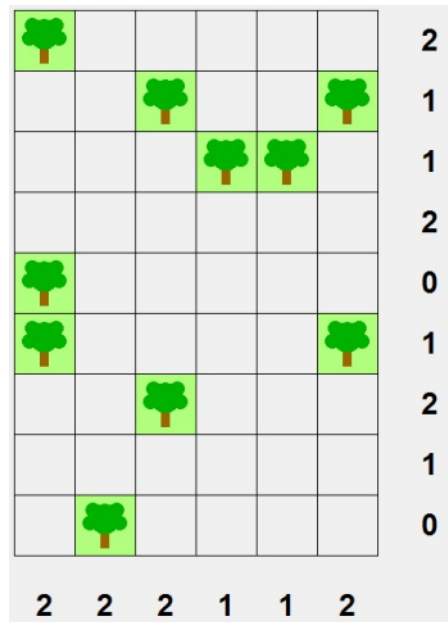
## Your Daily Warmup Puzzles

In bridge we manipulate puzzles involving numbers, symbols and words and strive for logical solutions (or at least inspired guesses). In each issue this week we will feature a pair of number/symbol puzzles, an easy one here on page two, and a harder one on the inside back cover; and, a word puzzle at the bottom of this page. In all of these puzzles, you will be able to solve them without guesswork, by logical deductions alone, which is what we're all trying to do at the table.

Today's puzzle is called **Tents**. It's yet another grid, but this time some of the cells have trees. You must find the empty cells that contain tents. Here are the constraints:

- there are exactly as many tents as trees
- each tent is horizontally or vertically (not diagonally) adjacent to one tree of its own, but may also be adjacent to other trees (even diagonally)
- no two tents are adjacent horizontally, vertically, nor even diagonally
- the number of tents in each row and column match the numbers on the right side and bottom of the grid

The easy version is below. Hints, and a more difficult puzzle will appear on page 15. Answers will appear in tomorrow's Daily Bulletin. For more warmups, check out the word puzzle on page 5.

without clues! There are exactly 10,000 words in the dictionary. The puzzles are designed so that only common English words are used, no centuries-old arcane words that are found in crosswords. You'll do best by looking for the locations of the hard letters first: Q, U, X, J. Be sure to mark off the letters used in the checking area beside the grid to keep track of your progress. It's not as difficult as it seems! I did most of these in 3-6 minutes.

A list of words in the puzzle (in alphabetical order) is on page 7. If you need a more limited hint, ask someone to examine the word list and tell you if the list contains, for example, a six-letter word starting with D and ending in E.

The Red Lion's Concession Stand will be open from 8:30am to 2pm and 6pm to 9pm daily on the playing floor level. They will also be selling tickets for a box lunch on Sunday for \$10.00. There will only be a short break on Sunday between the Swiss Team and the Fast Pairs games, so you may want to take advantage of the box lunches. The lunch will include sandwich, bottled water, cookie, and fruit. The sandwich choices include vegetarian wrap, turkey croissant, and roast beef on a kaiser roll.

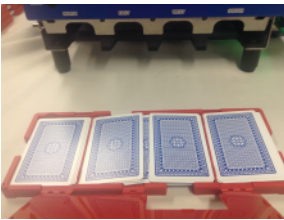
The Lounge will have Double Happy Hour in the bar from 9pm to closing. Watch the restaurant for meal specials and for special express items you can get quickly when gametime is imminent.

As you can see in the photo, our new boards and cards don't always drop down into the slots as intended. One factor is that the TournTables cards are new and slippery, allowing a bit of unwanted card migration, usually from East to West, not always caught (try as I might). Be sure to count your cards before you count your points!

A reminder to players not to wear cologne, perfume or scented lotions while attending bridge events. Some players have an extreme sensitivity to these scents, producing headaches or breathing problems, and since bridge requires us to be near one another, this puts these players at a severe disadvantage. The District has joined the ACBL in deciding not to adopt an official policy, instead relying on the goodwill of its members to refrain from using fragrances.

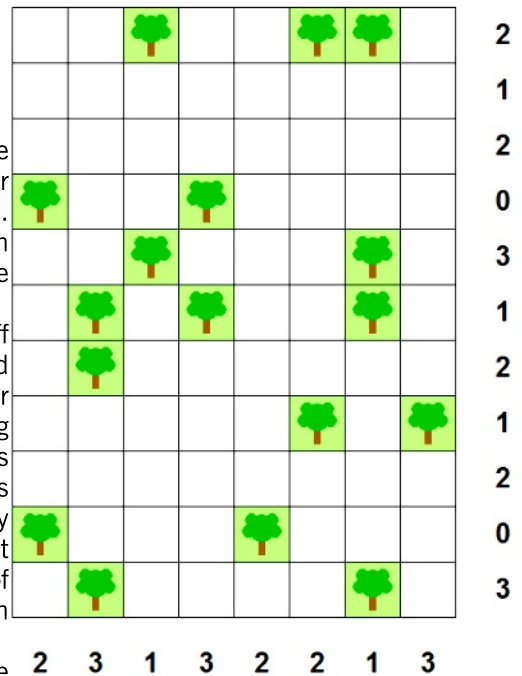

## Introductory Puzzle on Page 2

**Tents** recap: find the tents: there is one tent for every tree in the grid. Each tent has its own tree to which it is horizontally or vertically adjacent, but may be adjacent to other trees as well. No two tents are adjacent horizontally, vertically, nor even diagonally. The numbers on the right side and bottom indicate how many tents are in each row and column.

**Tents** hints: Alternate between two strategies: 1) Marking off cells where no tents can possibly be: rows or columns marked with a zero, and cells adjacent to no tree. 2) Looking for remaining possible spaces where there must be a tent and filling them in. Once you find a tent, you can mark off the cells adjacent to it (even diagonally). Whenever you mark off cells there is the possibility that a row or column will have only enough possible cells left to make it clear where the tents must go. Sometimes you can work out that a tent must be in one of two adjacent cells, which means that a third cell adjacent to both cannot contain a tent. You'll enjoy watching it come together.

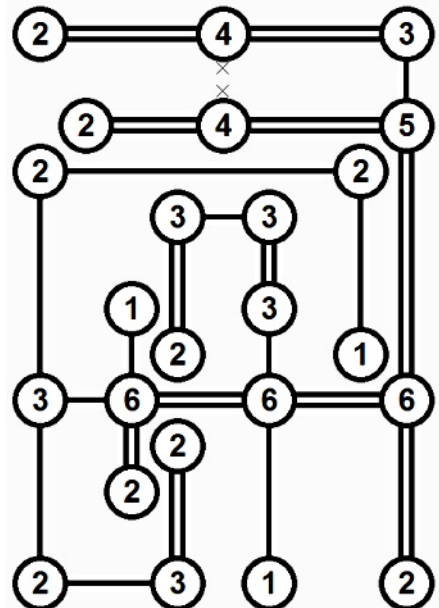
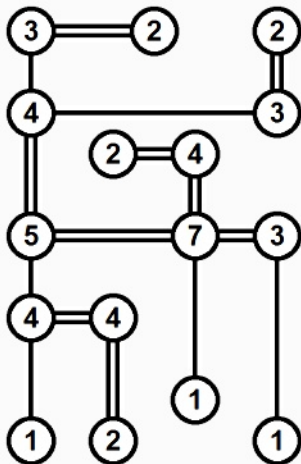
