Numbers, Symbols & Words

Your Daily Warmup Puzzles

In bridge we manipulate puzzles involving numbers, symbols and words and strive for logical solutions (or at least inspired guesses). In each issue this week we will feature a pair of number/symbol puzzles, an easy one here on page two, and a harder one on the inside back cover; and, a word puzzle at the bottom of this page. In all of these puzzles, you will be able to solve them without guesswork, by logical deductions alone, which is what we're all trying to do at the table.

Today's puzzle is called **Rectangles**. We start with a grid of cells, some of the cells with numbers in them. Your job is to divide the grid into rectangles of various sizes, such that:

- every rectangle contains one numbered cell

- the area (in cells) of each rectangle is equal to its number

Can't get much easier than that! Remember that squares are rectangles as well: a rectangle of size 9 may be 1x9 or 3x3 in size! The easy version is below. Hints, and a more difficult puzzle will appear on page 15. Answers will appear in tomorrow's Daily Bulletin. For more warmups, check out the word puzzle on page 5.

The players at the top of the list are full value for their awards, because the top bracket of knockouts is a proven test of bridge ability. But on most days there have been as many players playing pairs as teams here. Someone who wins virtually everything on that side of the room should be closer to the top of the points list.

Steve Hosh will be the featured speaker on Saturday. His topic is "Should I Open or Not?" 6:15 in the main playing area. I forgot that there was no Tips for Tops speaker on Thursday, when the I/N reception took place, and moved Steve and Dick Yarrington ahead a day.

The year ahead in District 19

On now: club qualifying period for the Grand National Teams, until approximately end of March. (Canadian clubs usually run their qualifying games after the new year, avoiding conflict with Canadian National Championship club games.) The District Final has not been announced yet, but is usually held in April, one for the Championship Flight and Flight B, and another for Flight A and Flight C. Winning teams in each flight represent District 19 at the National Championships at the Summer NABC.

Word puzzles this week are from an app called **Unoling**. It is a crossword without clues! There are exactly 26 blanks to fill in, and each letter of the alphabet fills one of the blanks. The puzzles are designed so that only common English words are used, no centuries-old arcane words that are found in crosswords. You'll do best by looking for the locations of the hard letters first: QU, X, J. Be sure to mark off the letters used in the checking area beside the grid to keep track of your progress. It's not as difficult as it seems! I did most of these in 3-6 minutes.

370 different players have won a total of 2634.02 masterpoints (37 more have played but have not won any) at the 2014 Olympia Regional. For those who have won masterpoints this is 7.12 points per player.

The Red Lion's Concession Stand will be open from 8:30am to 2pm and 6pm to 9pm daily on the playing floor level. They will also be selling tickets for a box lunch on Sunday for \$10.00. There will only be a short break on Sunday between the Swiss Team and Fast Pairs games, so you may want to take advantage of the box lunches. The lunch will include sandwich, bottled water, cookie, and fruit. The sandwich choices include vegetarian wrap, turkey croissant, and roast beef on a kaiser roll.

The Lounge will have Double Happy Hour in the bar from 9pm to closing. Watch the restaurant for meal specials and for special express items you can get quickly when gametime is imminent.

Despite a few distractions and difficulties (keep counting your cards, pairs players!), the new plastic open-up boards have saved a bit of time this week and no doubt will save considerable time for future Regionals as I get used to the new boards. District 19 and 20 got together to find a way to upgrade their equipment, and David Taylor has done a massive amount of work in setting the new sets up and loading them with new cards. Let's remember that because they are plastic, the tabs and edges can be broken if dropped or thrown. Let's try to avoid that.

A reminder to players not to wear cologne, perfume or scented lotions while attending bridge events. Some players have an extreme sensitivity to these scents, producing headaches or breathing problems, and since bridge requires us to be near one another, this puts these players at a severe disadvantage. The District has joined the ACBL in deciding not to adopt an official policy, instead relying on the goodwill of its members to refrain from using fragrances.

Oops Department continued: the note that Thursday Gold Rush winners **Karen Rise** and **Nobi Morris** really want to see you next November at the new Leavenworth Regional missed the mark slightly, because the tournament actually begins in late October: October 26 thru November 1, 2015. Check out the flyer in the hotel lobby. In fact, Saturday and Sunday are great days to take some flyers home with you, to display at your local club. Show your bridge-playing friends what fun a Regional is!

Tents Hints

Introductory Puzzle on Page 2

Rectangles recap: Divide the grid into rectangles of various sizes, so that each rectangle has a single numbered cell, and the area of each rectangle is equal to its numbered cell. Squares are rectangles too, don't forget!

Rectangles hints: Look for unusually high numbers or prime numbers. High numbers like 35 will be a 7x5 rectangle, and often there will be only one way to place it. Prime numbers like 2, 3, 5, 7, and 11 can only be a rectangle with a width or height of one, and can often be easily placed. As is so often the case with these puzzles, the optimum strategy often involves starting on the edges and working in. But be sure that there is only one way to make a rectangle of the given size before you mark it in—especially if you use a pen.

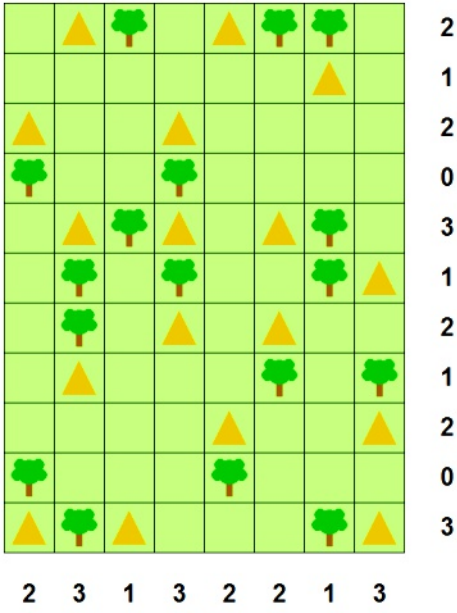
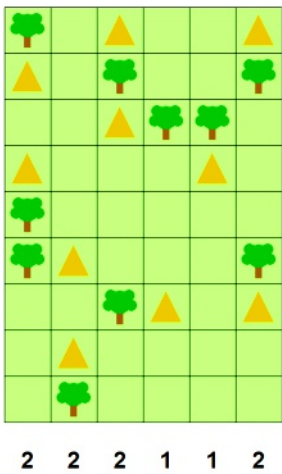
