Numbers, Symbols and Words

Your Daily Warmup Puzzles

In bridge we manipulate puzzles involving numbers, symbols and words and strive for logical solutions (or at least inspired guesses). In each issue this week we will feature a pair of number/symbol puzzles, an easy one here on page two, and a harder one on the inside back cover; and, a word puzzle at the bottom of this page. In all of these puzzles, you will be able to solve them without guesswork, by logical deductions alone, which is what we're all trying to do at the table.

Today's puzzle is called **Keen**. (It appears in several newspapers as **KenKen**.) Like Sudoku, your objective is to fill in the numbers 1 to the grid size, once in each column and row. Groups of cells marked off by thick lines are called 'cages.' The numbers within each cage must add, subtract, multiply, or divide to make the target number, listed at the top left of each cage with the math symbol. Unlike Sudoku, a cage may have the same number more than once, as long as the number does not appear twice in the same row or column.

The easy version is on this page. Hints, and a more difficult puzzle will appear on page 15, with an expert-level puzzle for the road on page 13. Answers will appear in the Wrapup issue of the Daily Bulletin.

only common English words are used, no centuries-old arcane words that are found in crosswords. You'll do best by looking for the locations of the hard letters first: QU, X, J. Be sure to mark off the letters used in the checking area beside the grid to keep track of your progress. It's not as difficult as it seems! I did most of these in 3-6 minutes.

A list of words in the puzzle (in alphabetical order) is on page 14. If you need a more limited hint, ask someone to examine the word list and tell you if the list contains, for example, a six-letter word starting with D and ending in E.

Be sure to have a look at the Bridge Results site for information on how to get a free membership, so you can have your photo appear with your name, have results involving you generate an e-mail letting you know they have been posted, use the online partnership desk, and other features of the site.

Still on for another week: North American Pairs club qualifying. Clubs have until August 31 to run NAP qualifying games at their regular sessions, no special sanction registration needed. An extra dollar or so per player is all it costs to award big masterpoint awards and qualify the top half of each strat to the District Final, which will be held in Fircrest in the Tacoma area this December:

Flight A and C (separate but concurrent): Saturday December 13, noon and 6pm.

Flight B, Sunday December 13, 10:30 and TBA.

Top three in each flight at the District Final are invited to New Orleans next March for the National Final at the NABC. If your club has not yet run a game, why not ask them to run one. Information on the games is at acbl.org.

The snack bar will be open 10:30 - 2:30 again today. There will be time for a quick run to one of the many nearby places in the break today. A seven course meal though, will have to wait until after the second session ends. Watch and listen for signs and announcements about the time to return.

Attendance seems to have dropped off to 2009 levels, which is a bit disappointing, but if you're reading this while holding a Bulletin in your hand you cannot be held accountable and we thank you for your attendance. I'm guessing that with such an accessible, spacious site in a fine, convenient location, the players will come back in 2015 and beyond and there will be better years ahead.

Saturday Open Pairs

How to break a half-time tie, by Roger Putnam and Marilyn Breeze

There was a tie for the lead at the break, broken decisively by event winners **Roger Putnam** and **Marilyn Breeze** with 47 matchpoints out of 51 in the very first round of the second session, after which cruise control was all that was required to win the event by about half a board. Flight B winners **Sharon Erwin** and **Allen Hamm** had 46½ out of 51 in their last round of the second session to win by nearly a full board. The Flight C winners **Huang Zeng** and **Shawn Ringwood** broke average in an extremely strong field of over 3000 points per player, finishing two boards ahead of the next under-750 pair.

Top on a board: 17. Average for the event was 459. Winning scores were 561½ (A), 499 (B), 466½ (C). To make the overalls you needed a total of 509½ (A), 450½ (B), 427½ (C). Average masterpoints for players in this event: 3083 (afternoon), 3056 (evening).

Kelsey’s Challenges

(problems on page 11)

Board 9: East should have the missing high cards outside of clubs, but can trumps be 2-2? The missing three of spades seems to indicate that the lead was from a doubleton, and West must have eight clubs for his pre-empt. Two trumps would leave a singleton heart, which would be led. If you have two trump losers, your losing spades will need to go on dummy's hearts. All this requires is...

...West to hold a doubleton ten of hearts. Queen of hearts from dummy at trick two, followed by a diamond to the king, cash South's aces, ruff a club, and lead the jack of hearts, ruffing East's king. Exiting with a diamond to East forces a lead to dummy and your spade losers disappear.

At the other table, the opponents doubled four

clubs and scored 300. You therefore gain 7 IMPs if you found the sequence of plays to make five diamonds. It costs 9 IMPs if you went down.

Board 10: Declarer cannot have the king of hearts or there is no hope to defeat this. To make up his bid he must have club honours, thus a club return is out.

A diamond lead is clear, hoping for a third-round ruff. But a low diamond will give declarer an entry to hand to finesse the queen of hearts and discard losers. The king of diamonds locks declarer in dummy and you shoot up with the ace of spades, give partner a diamond ruff, and later get a club trick.

At the other table, East played 3NT and South led the king of diamonds. This gave declarer access to dummy after the ace of spades had been dislodged and the contract made. Returning the king of diamonds wins 12 IMPs. Any other return loses one IMP. Did you win the match?

Edinburgh bridge writer Hugh Kelsey hit upon a great method of presenting interesting hands in a series of books in the 70s and 80s. The reader sat South for a 64 board match and was presented with a difficult problem to solve as declarer or on defense on each hand. Bidding and carding agreements were natural so as not to get in the way of the problems.

Keen Hints

Introductory Puzzle on Page 2

Keen recap: Fill the grid in Sudoku-style, no repeat numbers in rows or columns. The cages (areas boxed in by thick lines) must add, subtract, multiply or divide to the target number indicated.

Keen hints: Some cages immediately fill themselves: a two-cell cage marked 11+ in a size-6 grid must be 5 and 6 (or 6 and 5). No other cell in that row or column can have 5s or 6s. Once you can reduce the possibilities for a cell down to a handful of possible numbers, write the possibles in small figures and look for further clues to help you complete rows and columns. You'll be working out numbers mostly from the cage clues at the outset, and complete the puzzle using Sudoku-style strategies (what number is left to go here?)

Now can you do the easy puzzle on page 2?
How about the more difficult one on this page?
Still too easy? Try the one on page 13!
