# Numbers, Symbols & Words

## Your Daily Warmup Puzzles

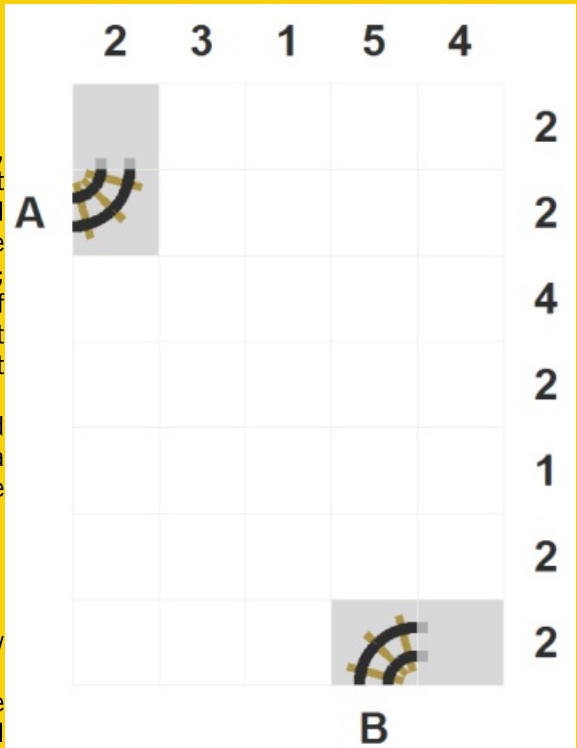
In bridge we manipulate puzzles involving numbers, symbols and words and strive for logical solutions (or at least inspired guesses). In each issue this week we will feature a pair of number/symbol puzzles, an easy one here on page two, and a harder one on the inside back cover; and, a word puzzle at the bottom of this page. In all of these puzzles, you will be able to solve them without guesswork, by logical deductions alone, which is what we're all trying to do at the table.

Today's puzzle is called **Tracks**. Your objective is to find the complete track running from A to B. There are no extra track sections not part of the A to B line. Each cell in the grid contains either:

- no track at all, or
- straight track without a turn, or
- a track with a ninety-degree turn

The numbers on top and on the right side indicate how many grid squares in that column or row contain track.

The easy version is above right. Hints, and a more difficult puzzle will appear on page 15. Answers will appear in tomorrow's Daily Bulletin. For more warmups, check out the word puzzle below.



Word puzzles this week are from an app called **Unolingo**. It is a crossword without clues! There are exactly 26 blanks to fill in, and each letter of the alphabet fills one of the blanks. The puzzles are designed so that

only common English words are used; there are no unfamiliar, arcane centuries-old words found only in crossword puzzles. You'll do best by looking for the locations of the hard letters first: QU, X, J. Be sure to mark off the letters used in the checking area beside the grid to keep track of your progress. It's not as difficult as it seems! I did most of these in 3-6 minutes.

A list of words in the puzzle (in alphabetical order) is on page 5. If you need a more limited hint, ask someone to examine the word list and tell you if the list contains, for example, a six-letter word starting with D and ending in E.



# Notes & Notables

## Ready for the weekend?

The weather app on my iPod says we are about to see more of the same, as Thursday brought clear skies, and a slightly better number of players. It just didn't seem like a Victoria Regional those first few days with the overcast and cool. Now with the influx of weekend players and some more characteristic Victoria spring skies, we'll be back to what people expect out of the tournament.

Or will we? The results Thursday included a third straight Open Pairs win for Sandra and Doug Fraser, and a Gold Rush victory for Elsie MacKinnon and Ivy Pye, who were, believe it or not, THIRTY-THIRD at halftime. There were more ties in the Evening Swiss than in a typical Serie A weekend. And the Hideous Hog-In-Training picked both semifinalists and the winner in one of the knockout brackets. (But not the others, of course.)

Duncan Smith is the presenter at Speaker's Corner today, from 6:20 - 6:40 or so. Return from the break a little early and get some tips from one of the best players in B.C!

Purchase entries by credit or debit card! Entry coupons are sold at the front of the room, before evening and afternoon sessions. You still need to get in the main line for entries, so give yourself enough time to purchase your coupons.

It is time to begin thinking about Sunday plans. Noon Saturday is the deadline to pre-order a Sunday lunch from the concession stand at the back of the room.

One of the most common questions I get at tournaments while I am taking pictures and duplicating boards and preparing Daily Bulletins is "do you actually play bridge?" It looks like we may get an answer to that question. District 19 and District 20 got together last year to purchase new fliptop boards to make my job (and David Taylor's in many District 20 tournaments) easier by having many more sets of boards available. David is also helping me by duplicating the Monday and Tuesday boards in

advance. And I have had some great help from several of the caddies this week, too. As a result, I will be finished duplicating boards today, and will have Saturday and Sunday free to play. Here is the sort of thing you can expect:

Your opponents bid to 6NT and you are on opening lead. The uncontested auction, beginning with LHO as dealer, was 1♦ - 1♠ - 1NT - 3♣ - 6NT.

You lead the 2♥ and dummy, on your left, has:

♠ AQ984 ♥ A98 ♦ T ♣ AKJ8

Your hand is:

♠ T63 ♥ Q632 ♦ J87 ♣ T75

Partner covers the nine of hearts with the ten and declarer wins the king. He crosses to the king of clubs and leads the ten of diamonds to his queen, partner following with the five. Another club to the king (partner has followed with the two and now the three of clubs) in dummy is followed by the four of spades from dummy. Partner plays the two, declarer plays the five. You are in with your six. What do you lead now?

A heart looks safe, doesn't it. Partner must have the jack; surely declarer would have won the jack at trick one otherwise. Unless this is what declarer **wants** you to think:

Board 24 6NT by West	♠ T63 ♥ Q632 ♦ J87 ♣ T75	West Deals None Vul

The king of diamonds would be declarer's eleventh trick, if he had won the jack of hearts at trick one. But a 4-2 spade split would beat 6NT. Instead, declarer found this gambit, smoothly winning the king at trick one, to cater to 4-2 spades—if you fall for the trap. Leading a heart gives declarer a third heart trick, and four spades unless they are 5-1 or 6-0. Did I find the diamond switch to grab the setting trick? Of course not. I was declarer.

# Thursday Anne Porter Open Pairs

Stop me if this sounds familiar...

Over ten years of Daily Bulletins and I have not seen this before: three consecutive two-session Open Pairs wins for **Sandra** and **Doug Fraser**, who were just behind the leaders at the half and turned on the overdrive in the evening for a win by about a board. Four Victoria pairs took the top four spots. The under-2000 strat was won by **Henry** and **Joyce Lust** of Nanaimo, who held their own in the evening session as the Flight A pairs were shooting for big scores.



Top on a board: 17. Average for the event was 459. Winning scores were 568.47 (A), 494.88 (B). To make the overalls you needed a total of 499.24 (A), 438.03 (B). Average masterpoints for players in this event: 3912 (afternoon), 3871 (evening).

## 71% in the evening puts Elsie and Ivy in the winners circle!

Another one for the record books. At halftime, event winners **Elsie Mackinnon** and **Ivy Pye** were *thirty-third* overall! 71% in the evening session left them ahead with a full board to spare! Bridge Results shows their evening session had one zero, only two other boards below 30%, and fourteen out of 24 boards at 70% or more, including four tops! Second were Victoria's **Jon Punnett** and **Bob Macdonald**, who had the best score in the afternoon and took the under-300 strat.

Top on a board: 8. Average for the event was 168. Winning scores were 199 (7), 182½ (3). To make the overalls you needed a total of 192 (7), 180 (3). Average masterpoints for players in this event: 295 (both sessions).

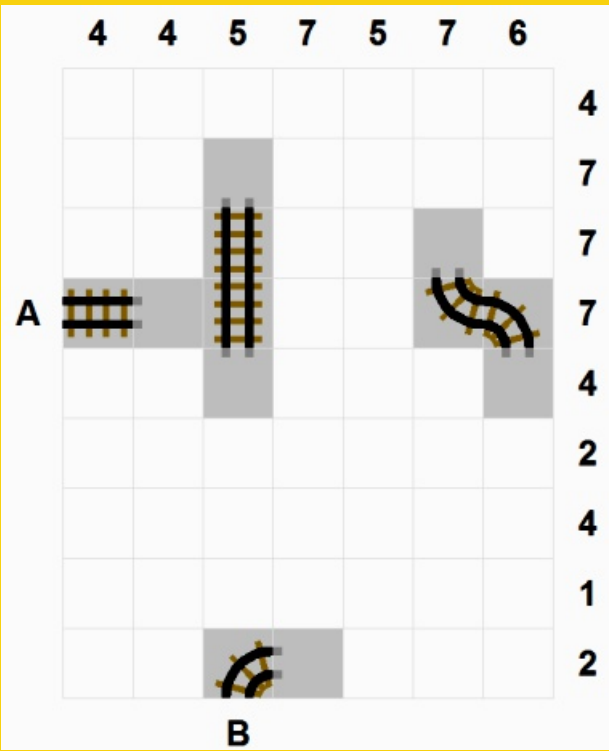

## Introductory Puzzle on Page 2

**Tracks** recap: Find the single line of track from A to B, using the clues that tell you how many cells in each row or column contain track. Each cell can contain no track, a straight-through track section, or a section with a ninety-degree turn.

**Tracks** hints: First find out the cells (or most of the cells) that contain track by drawing an X in cells that cannot contain any track and lightly colouring in those that must contain track, based on the numeric clues. Track near the edges or corners must turn to avoid going out of bounds. Two adjacent cells known to contain track may not necessarily contain track that connects those cells!

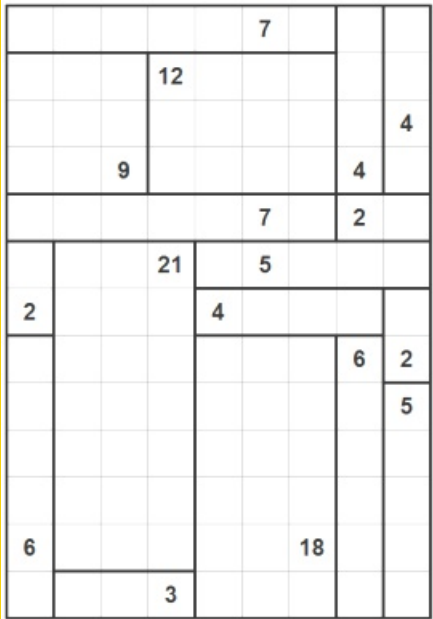
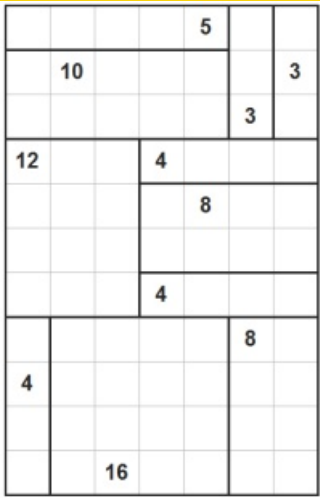
