Numbers, Symbols & Words

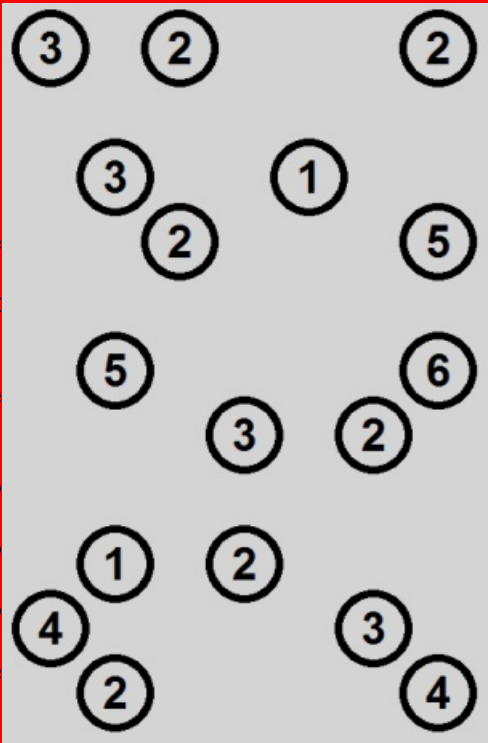
Your Daily Warmup Puzzles

In bridge we manipulate puzzles involving numbers, symbols and words and strive for logical solutions (or at least inspired guesses). In each issue this week we will feature a pair of number/symbol puzzles, an easy one here on page two, and a harder one on the inside back cover; and, a word puzzle at the bottom of this page. In all of these puzzles, you will be able to solve them without guesswork, by logical deductions alone, which is what we're all trying to do at the table.

Today's puzzle is called **Bridges**. We start with islands that have numbers in them. Your objective is to connect these islands with bridges, such that:

- all bridges are straight lines that go left-right or up-down. No diagonals, turns, or slants.
- the number of bridges terminating at any island is equal to the number written in that island
- islands can be connected with one bridge or with two parallel bridges, but no more than two
- it must be possible to get from any island to any other via the network of bridges
- no bridges may cross one another or go over an island

The easy version is at right. Hints, and a more difficult puzzle will appear on page 15. Answers will appear in tomorrow's Daily Bulletin. For more warmups, check out the word puzzle below.



Word puzzles this week are from an app called **Unoling**. It is a crossword without clues! There are exactly 26 blanks to fill in, and each letter of the alphabet fills one of the blanks. The puzzles are designed so that

only common English words are used; there are no unfamiliar, arcane centuries-old words found only in crossword puzzles. You'll do best by looking for the locations of the hard letters first: QU, X, J. Be sure to mark off the letters used in the checking area beside the grid to keep track of your progress. It's not as difficult as it seems! I did most of these in 3-6 minutes.

A list of words in the puzzle (in alphabetical order) is on page 10. If you need a more limited hint, ask someone to examine the word list and tell you if the list contains, for example, a six-letter word starting with D and ending in E.

These are their session scores this week (the first is from Monday evening):

58.00%, 66.03%, 62.02%, 58.50%, 60.68%, 59.91%, 63.94%, 63.18%, 62.08%.

This is a Tiger Woods/Wayne Gretzky/Michael Jordan level of dominance. They seldom lead at the dinner break, they just go out and put together another excellent session, and wait for the results to confirm that they are the only pair that can sustain that level. Even the two worst sessions would make the high overalls easily in any event this week.

Dynasty! Sandra & Doug Fraser win FOURTH straight all day open pairs.

Once again, **Doug** and **Sandra Fraser** were unbeatable, the only pair to string two sessions of 60%+ together, winning by a full board. The Flight B and C winners, **Nev Hircock** and **Heather Erskine**, scored enough points to make **Nev Hircock** a new Life Master. (He is still on the NLM leaderboard since it is based on status as the tournament begins.)

Top on a board: 23 (first session top of 17 was factored up). Average for the event was 621. Winning scores were 777.85 (A), 701.82 (B, C). To make the overalls you needed a total of 658.32 (A), 636.62 (B, C). Average masterpoints for players in this event: 2491 (afternoon), 2449 (evening).

DINO Board Meeting

Victoria: April 13, 2015

(As always, we thank District Nineteen secretary Dudley Brown for this synopsis of Monday's District Board Meeting.)

1. The Treasurer's Reports for 2014 were accepted and will be placed on the DINO Web Site. (They are printed on page 6.) In short, the report showed assets of \$241,348, liabilities of \$7,974 which meant members' equity of \$233,374. Total net income was \$26,560, and total expenses were \$40,425, for a deficit of \$13,865 for 2014. Burnaby, Penticton, Lynnwood, and Olympia Regionals all showed a net income.

2. A Regional was approved for Whistler BC for November 7-13, 2016, due to the Spring 2016 Reno

NABC in the District's usual calendar spot.

3. The Board accepted Marv Norden's proposal to be the District Webmaster and agreed to let him redo the District Web Site. He will get input from Board Members and will set parameters of what can be placed on the site.

4. Entry fees for District Regionals in 2014 were set at \$14 Canadian for British Columbia Regionals and \$13 U.S. for Washington Regionals.

5. Cameron Doner and Ralph Lipe were appointed to fill the vacancies on the ACBL Board of Governors.

6. Credit card purchases of entry fees will be valid for the same year and same country.

7. The President scheduled a special Board Meeting during the Lynnwood Regional specifically for strategies planning.

Introductory Puzzle on Page 2

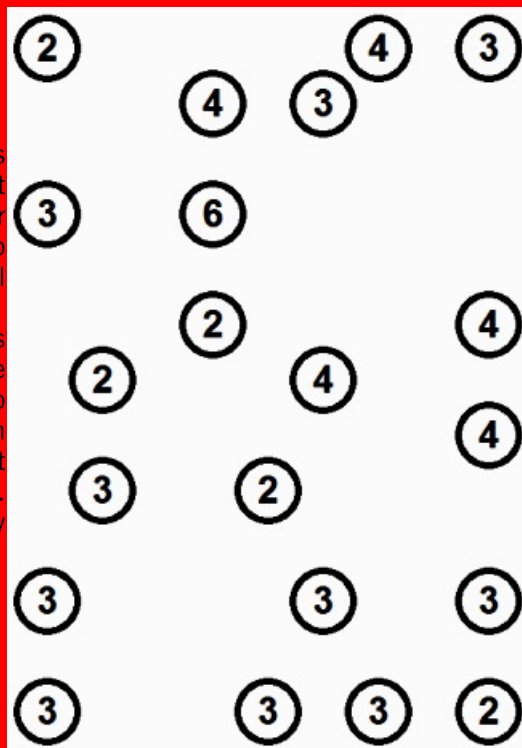
Bridges recap: Connect the islands (the circles) with bridges that run left-right or up-down and do not cross. You must connect all of the islands together and each island's number indicates the total number of bridges that lead into it. Two islands can be connected with one bridge, or two parallel bridges.

Bridges hints: Quite often you can fill in most of the bridges from an island just by reason. A '3' island in a corner (or one that can connect to two others only) must have one bridge to each (which you can fill in) and one bridge in parallel (which you'll need to figure out). Watch the '1' islands and connect them whenever there is only one island they can connect to. You might want to colour in the islands that cannot have any more bridges leading from them, but only if you're sure.

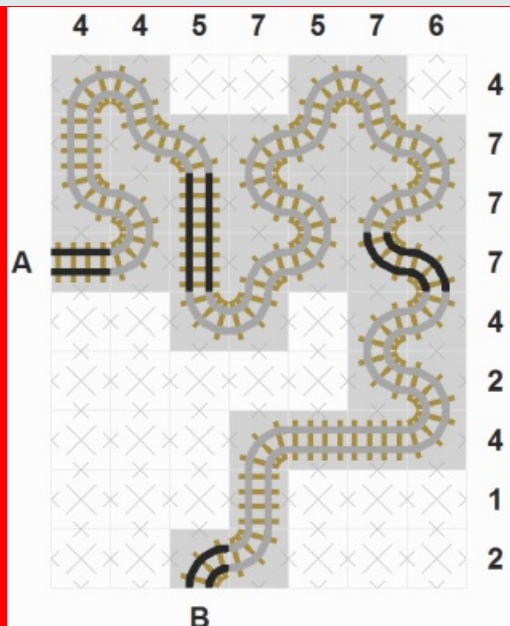
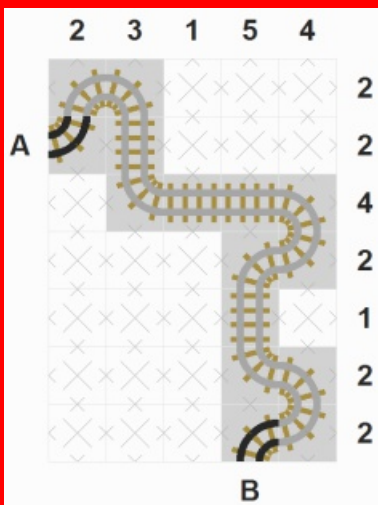
