Ayers and Smith led at halftime and just cleared 60% in the evening, winning by almost a half a board, conforming to McBruce's Infallible Rule: two 60% sessions equals a win (unless someone else does even better). The under-2000 winners were **Lorraine Hayne** and **John Crouch**, who were more than a board ahead and finished 9th overall with a strong evening session.


### **Bridges Hints**

#### **Introductory Puzzle on Page 2**

**Bridges** recap: Connect the islands (the circles) with bridges that run left-right or up-down and do not cross. You must connect all of the islands together and each island's number indicates the total number of bridges that lead into it. Two islands can be connected with one bridge, or two parallel bridges.

**Bridges** hints: Quite often you can fill in most of the bridges from an island just by reason. A '3' island in a corner (or one that can connect to two others only) must have one bridge to each (which you can fill in) and one bridge in parallel (which you'll need to figure out). Watch the '1' islands and connect them whenever there is only one island they can connect to. You might want to colour in the islands that cannot have any more bridges leading from them, but only if you're sure.

Now can you do the easy puzzle on page 2? How about the more difficult one on this page? Also, check the word puzzle on page 2.



Answers will appear in tomorrow's issue. The number/symbol puzzles were generated by software available (for all computers or smartphones) at this site — www.chiark.greenend.org.uk/~sgtatham/puzzles/ — where you will find over three dozen types of such puzzles and controls to suit any size and difficulty level.

### **DINO Recorder**

The main role of the Recorder is to receive written information, complaints and suggestions by players about other players, tournament directors, tournament facilities and anything else directly related to bridge.

The Recorder's Duties:

- The Recorder keeps ongoing records of all grievances brought to his attention, the facts of which he is able to verify. Absolute confidentiality is observed.
- The Recorder has no punitive powers. If a hearing does take place, however, the Recorder's records may be made available to the Committee as evidence.
  - The Recorder will review memos received and determine how the issue is to be acted upon. He may investigate to determine the facts and possible extenuating circumstances.
- The Recorder acts as an educator. Many players do not understand ethics and rules. The Recorder is able to help newer players, and others, become aware of each player's ethical responsibilities.

To report an incident to the District Recorder, obtain a Player Memo form from a Director. All Player Memos should be completed as fully as possible and returned to the Recorder or to a Director.
