Numbers, Symbols & Words

Your Daily Warmup Puzzles

In bridge we manipulate puzzles involving numbers, symbols and words and strive for logical solutions (or at least inspired guesses). In each issue this week we will feature a pair of number/symbol puzzles, an easy one here on page two, and a harder one on the inside back cover; and, a word puzzle at the bottom of this page. In all of these puzzles, you will be able to solve them without guesswork, by logical deductions alone, which is what we're all trying to do at the table.

Today's puzzle is called **Keen**. (It appears in several newspapers as KenKen.) Like Sudoku, your objective is to fill in the numbers 1 to the grid size, once in each column and row. Groups of cells marked off by thick lines are called 'cages.' The numbers within each cage must add, subtract, multiply, or divide to make the target number, listed at the top left of each cage with the math symbol. Unlike Sudoku, a cage may have the same number more than once, as long as the number does not appear twice in the same row or column.

The easy version is above. Hints, and a more difficult puzzle will appear on page 23. An expert-level version is on page 19. Answers will appear in the Wrapup issue of the Daily Bulletin.

Word puzzles this week are from an app called **Unolingo**. It is a crossword without clues! There are exactly 26 blanks to fill in, and each letter of the alphabet fills one of the blanks. The puzzles are designed so that

only common English words are used; there are no unfamiliar, arcane centuries-old words found only in crossword puzzles. You'll do best by looking for the locations of the hard letters first: QU, X, J. Be sure to mark off the letters used in the checking area beside the grid to keep track of your progress. It's not as difficult as it seems! I did most of these in 3-6 minutes.



A list of words in the puzzle (in alphabetical order) is on page 4. If you need a more limited hint, ask someone to examine the word list and tell you if the list contains, for example, a six-letter word starting with D and ending in E.

Okanagan Notes

Forty-one years!

The first Penticton Regional was in 1974, the second and third in 1978 and 1982. Starting in 1985 it took place every third year, then later every second year, and annually since 2002. This is the first Penticton Regional without **Roger Putnam** directing, and the first since the 1980s that **Martin Ware** has not been on the directing staff.

It looks like a near-certainty that this year's edition of the tournament will hit 3,000 tables again, after last year came just a bit short of that mark. Even the representatives at the National Finals, which will be held at the Spring 2016 NABC in Reno NV, next March.

Don't forget to visit the TournTables area for those today, for they will be closing down shortly after the lunch break. Today is also a very good day to pick up Canadians, for the site is the Aqua Room at the Skagit tournament flyers and extra copies of the Daily PUD #1: PUD, it turns out, stands for Public Utility Bulletin to take home to your local clubs, where District. players who do not normally attend tournaments can read about them and reconsider their stance in future. The more the merrier!

Event winner prizes are now available near the concession stand. Overall winners of Open Pairs, Gold Rush Pairs, Side Game Series (the individual series winner, not the individual games), and bracket winners (limited to four prizes per team) are eligible. There is one more edition of the Daily Bulletin to come, with Sunday results and photos, final masterpoint charts of all types (including a red-gold breakdown for everyone who won masterpoints at the tournament, plus charts for teams, pairs, side games, knockouts, 199ers, and more) as well as updated Kirkwood Trophy standings. All this, and the week's photos on the photos page, should be online by about 2am Monday morning, possibly earlier.

It's North American Pairs time at clubs, and this year there is a new location for the District Final. In June, July and August, clubs may hold high-paying NAP games. Players qualify for the District Final by

finishing in the top half within each stratum, but you can play as many of these high-masterpoint-yield games as you wish. The District Final will be held in Mt. Vernon WA, on Saturday November 14 (noon and 5pm) and Sunday November 15 (10:30am and 3:30pm).

The Saturday game is for Flights A (unlimited) and C (non-LM), played separately. Sunday's game is for Flight B (0-2500). The top three pairs in each game will win a subsidy to play as one of the District 19 representatives at the National Finals, which will be held at the Spring 2016 NABC in Reno NV, next March.

Mt. Vernon WA is about an hour's drive south of the border and an hour's drive north of downtown Seattle. The flyer DINO produced for the event confused some Canadians, for the site is the Aqua Room at the Skagit

Keen Hints

Introductory Puzzle on Page 2

Keen recap: Fill the grid in Sudoku-style, no repeat numbers in rows or columns. The cages (areas boxed in by thick lines) must add, subtract, multiply or divide to the target number indicated.

Keen hints: Some cages immediately fill themselves: a two-cell cage marked 11+ in a size-6 grid must be 5 and 6 (or 6 and 5). No other cell in that row or column can have 5s or 6s. Once you can reduce the possibilities for a cell down to a handful of possible numbers, write the possibles in small figures and look for further clues to help you complete rows and columns. You'll be working out numbers mostly from the cage clues at the outset, and complete the puzzle using Sudoku-style strategies (what number is left to go here?)

Now can you do the easy puzzle on page 2?

How about the more difficult one on this page, or the expert-level version on page 19? Also, check the word puzzle on page 2.
