Letter From The President

Welcome to another year of Killdeer Island Club events and activities. This is our 84th year since Kelsey Purdy set up the Killdeer Island Club Inc. and granted the land within Killdeer Island to us on October 8th 1930. Over the years the past meeting minutes make exciting reading as many problems have cropped up and required solutions. Strong personalities have made their presence known. Leaders have emerged. The club has survived through depression, world war, recession and changing times. From a mainly summer community we have primarily year round residents. The small lake cottages are for the most part gone and larger homes have been built. We have water services (1963), many paved roads, sewers (1995), street lights (which are currently in the ON position) and other amenities. The Killdeer Island Club has been forefront in pushing forward many of these services for our community.

The problems that we as a club must deal with continue to evolve. After reading the minutes of the club since its formation this seems to be part of our history. Participation in the club by as many island residents as possible is important to allow us to continue our major mandates. The Killdeer Island Club board navigates the club through the major speed bumps so that the main membership can enjoy the more social aspects of the club.

The Derelict Fee Statute Law enacted decades after we were formed was one of the recent threats to our control of our Lake Access Properties. We raised funds and successfully fought this in Land Court last year. Over the years various structures have encroached onto our properties and these need to be dealt with as they are found. The board tries to negotiate amicable solutions, which involve mediated permissive use agreements if at all possible. We are still in the process of solving one of these issues now. Lastly, some individuals feel that they have the right to use our property as they see fit without being members and paying club voted on dues and fees. As this threatens our existence this has become our current legal issue.

Through all this time, the club has continued to provide its two key charters: the first being the successful protection of our land, and the second being the social aspect of the club. I think that this will be a banner year for the Killdeer Island Club. We have many events for all Killdeer residents. There will be our meetings throughout the season, a barbecue in June, Pancake breakfast, The Luau at the end of July, the 130 club banquet, Whist party, Walk About and other events TBD such as recycle events and the neighborhood yard sale. We are investigating electronically archiving our historical records to protect them for future generations. Surveys are being done and the results recorded at the registry of deeds to decrease the likelihood of future encroachments. The meetings will probably continue to be lively. And all of this will be recorded in our meeting minutes so club members in the future can look back on what we were doing at this point in time.

The 2014 boating season is fast approaching and boaters will be looking for dock space. Anyone who had a dock in 2013, and is a member in good standing, will get first choice for the same spot for 2014. Dock fees and membership dues must be paid BEFORE your docks can be placed in the water. We require that you pay your club dues (\$40.00 per member) and \$150.00 for each gas-powered watercraft by April 30th. If your dues and boat fees are not paid by April 30th, you may lose your dock spot. The only people allowed to store their docks on club property, without charge, in the off-season are those with paid up boat fees. Others may store docks on club property during the winter for \$50. You are also reminded that docks should be stored in an orderly manner.
