The 2016 boating season is fast approaching and boaters will be looking for dock space. Anyone who had a dock in 2015, and is a member in good standing, will get first choice for the same spot for 2016. **Dock fees and membership dues must be paid BEFORE your docks can be placed in the water.** We require that you pay your club dues (\$40.00 per member) and \$150.00 for each gas-powered watercraft by April 30th. **If your dues and boat fees are not paid by April 30th, you may lose your dock spot.** The only people allowed to store their docks on club property in the off-season are those with paid up boat fees. You are also reminded that docks should be stored in an orderly manner.
