The 2016 boating season is fast approaching and boaters will be looking for dock space. Anyone who had a dock in 2015, and is a member in good standing, will get first choice for the same spot for 2016. Dock fees and membership dues must be paid BEFORE your docks can be placed in the water. We require that you pay your club dues (\$40.00 per member) and \$150.00 for each gaspowered watercraft by April 30<sup>th</sup>. If your dues and boat fees are not paid by April 30<sup>th</sup>, you may lose your dock spot. The only people allowed to store their docks on club property in the off-season are those with paid up boat fees. You are also reminded that docks should be stored in an orderly manner.
