In 2010 TWF added Take Wings Male Youth Program to its previously all-girls program.

ABOUT TERRI J. VAUGHN:

Terri J. Vaughn has entertained us on television for eight seasons as a series regular. First, she stole America's heart with her lovable portrayal of *Lovita Alizay Jenkins* on the WB's "The Steve Harvey Show." After that, Vaughn made her way to UPN's "All of Us." Currently, she is a cast member on the hit TBS television sit-com "Tyler Perry's Meet the Browns." Among her film credits are "Three Can Play That Game," "Tyler Perry's Daddy's Little Girls," "Redrum," and "Angels Can't Help But Laugh." Vaughn has been honored with three Image Awards for Outstanding Supporting Actress, a nomination for a 2005 BET Comedy Award, and she also got a nod for BET Outstanding Supporting Actress in a Drama Series for her work on "Soulfood."

But, before Vaughn ever had her first audition, she was growing up in a housing project in San Francisco's Hunter's Point district. Today, she is determined to create positive, inspirational and educational experiences for teens growing up in disadvantaged communities.
