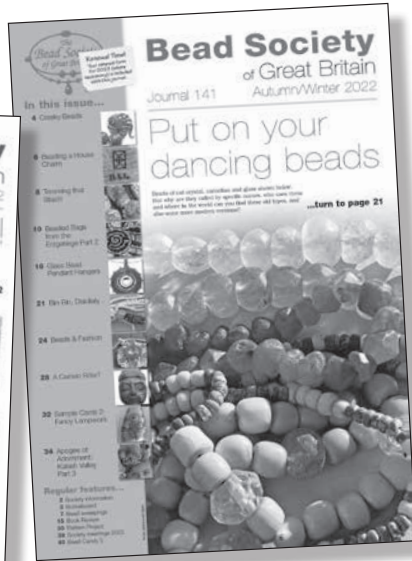

The Society usually holds an AGM and a workshop each year. This 2-day meeting is usually on Friday/Saturday or Saturday/Sunday at a venue in the UK. In addition, the Bead Society Journal (an informative illustrated colour publication) is sent to members 3 times a year.
