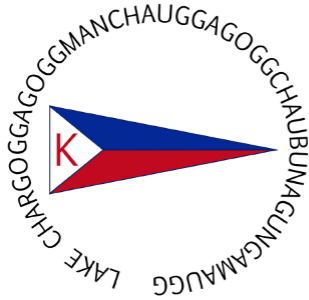

September: Fifth and final meeting of the year - 130 Club Dinner was held at the Lodge.

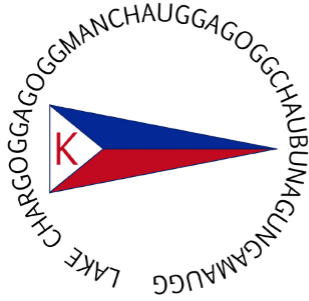
